A Letter From Our Pastor

4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Consider the verse, "Joseph, ...since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame..." The Hebrew word for "righteousness" meant much more than merely fair, just, or virtuous as it does today. It included one's complete relationship with God AND how that shaped one's interaction with others. The church leaders of Joseph's time practiced punishment and isolation for sinners; thankfully, Joseph's relationship with God far surpassed theirs.

Please engage in a little Lectio Divina with me here, and join me in imagining the scene.

Imagine you are Joseph. Mary has just returned from helping Elizabeth. You rush to welcome her into your arms, but she's distant. You immediately notice something is wrong in her face. You pause, confused, with a look that says, "What is it, my love?" Then you see the bump of Jesus protruding from her womb. The shock, disbelief, and overwhelming sense of betrayal wash over you! NO! This can't be! Your eyes open wide, and you try to speak, but no words come out. Mary rushes toward you, but you turn away and walk off. The silence is broken by her tears. She sobs, "Joseph, wait! Don't leave me!"

You fill in the blanks from there since scripture is silent, and we'll all have to wait till heaven to find out what actually went down. Did he bolt, give her a chance to explain, scoff and call her crazy when she told the truth? Did he brood for weeks before coming to his decision? The romantic in me wants to believe somehow he saw the truth in her beautiful eyes and angelic face, and although his mind couldn't process the reality, he wanted to believe with all his heart in her mindboggling explanation.

However, let's not overlook the seriousness of her situation at that time. Her life was completely in Joseph's hands. If he publicly revealed that the child was not his, The Law called for Mary to be stoned. He faced the choice to expose her, marry her and raise a child he hadn't fathered, or to end the marriage process and have everyone believe he was the father. That would damage his reputation, but Mary's life would be spared. So he voluntarily took on the shame of being the father of her child, knowing he and Mary would be looked down upon, but at least her life would be saved. That's what he chose, of course, prior to the angel's direct intervention.

Thank you, Joseph, for your nobility, for your righteousness, for your trust in God. May we all practice the same Hebrew version of righteousness.


