A Letter From Our Pastor

RESPECT LIFE



This week, many from our diocese and across the country will be in Washington to cry out for the unborn, who remain at risk in our society. The Supreme Court decision allowing states to determine whether life is valued or trashed within their borders did not end the killings, and many estimate that the number of living, thriving, developing humans being sacrificed has, in fact, increased.

The outcry by those who value their self-centered “right” to engage in sexual activity, regardless of consequences - even over the life of their very own offspring, has been enormous, and we have much work ahead of us to soften these hearts of stone and open them to the treasure of life, lived as God intends.

To that end, we have been asked to consecrate Thursday, January 22nd, as a special day of prayer and penance, called “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn.”

Please consider that the far-reaching impacts of this twisted mentality that some lives can be discarded at the choosing of others extend well past the issue of abortion. Everyone knows the terms zygote, embryo, fetus, newborn, toddler, adolescent, adult, and elderly describe stages of human life. Each of us has or will go through them, God willing. None of these depicts a doorknob or some other inanimate object that one day magically becomes alive and human, or ceases to be human.

If one set of individuals can be empowered to end a human life in one of these stages, why not someone else in another stage? Want to stop the killing in our streets? Let’s start by reversing the notion that lives that interfere with others’ desires can be ended.

This same twisted mindset brought many of the grave injustices of the past, from slavery to wars. Thinking of people as mere things or objects that stand in the way of what we want. We must confront it everywhere it surfaces, including fundamental prejudices as Dr. Martin Luther King took on - at the cost of his life.

All human life is precious, in every stage, color, nationality, shape, and form.

It’s time we close Pandora’s death box and flood the world with God’s grace flowing through responsible choices. Let’s go back to the chaste blueprints He gave us so we can experience a joy and fulfillment no earthly “goods” can produce, especially those gained at the cost of another’s life.

NOVENA FOR LIFE CONTINUES

The St. Thomas More Knights of Columbus invite all parishioners to join them in praying a **Novena for Life**, which aligns with the national "9 Days for Life" initiative sponsored by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) from January 16–24. This nationwide effort focuses on prayer for the sanctity of human life and helps foster a culture of life, especially as we approach the anniversary of Roe v. Wade and the annual March for Life.

Parishioners are encouraged to come together in prayer daily at 6:00 p.m. in the Mother Teresa Room on non-Mass days, and immediately following Mass in the church on Mass days through Jan. 24. Let us unite in prayer for the protection and dignity of all human life.

Children's Church Set To Begin

Children's Church is a new ministry offered during the 10:00 a.m. Mass, providing age-appropriate faith formation during the Liturgy of the Word. Potty-trained toddlers through first graders are invited to participate. Children exit with facilitators after the Opening Prayer and return to Mass following the homily. Instruction will be held in the Activity Center meeting rooms.

Children's Church will be offered once a month to start on the following dates: **January 18, February 8, March 1, April 12, and May 17.** Additional dates will be added as the ministry grows.




