Data Analyst Services Roster

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Mawkim, the Data Governance Team, which is currently housed under UNSM's Capacity Development department, administers data related projects on behalf of First Nations communities in Nova Scotia and Newfoundland.

The Mawkim Team is working to establish a Mi'kmaq Regional Data Centre that is L'nu led and aligned with community priorities and embodies the First Nations Principles of OCAP®. The team coordinates national level surveys, including the First Nations Regional Health Survey, the First Nations Regional Early Childhood Education, and Employment Development Survey, and the new First Nations Regional Social Survey.

To support the growing demand for data services across Mi'kmaw communities, the Mawkim Team is seeking to establish a roster of qualified Data Analysts available for short-term contract work. This initiative will support readiness to respond to evolving data needs in the short, medium, and long-term while ensuring data services align with community priorities and principles.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must demonstrate their relevant experience providing data analysis services such as: Data Management & Integration, Data Analysis, Report Writing & Data Visualization, Strategic & Analytical Advice, and Knowledge Sharing & Support.

Experience in working with First Nations organizations is considered an asset and must be clearly demonstrated in their submission.

PROFESSIONAL FEES

Professional fees will be determined on an hourly or project-based rate as proposed by the applicant and will be subject to a signed Service Agreement.

Interested applicants should submit a cover letter and resume to the email below. Submissions will be accepted on an ongoing basis.
