



What is Angel Tree?

The Angel Tree Letters was founded by Prison Fellowship Singapore (PFS) in 2005 with a vision to bring the hearts of inmates and their loved ones together during the Christmas season. Over the years, we have witnessed inmates encountering Christ in prison and how they were transformed by the Word of God. Through this initiative, they get the opportunity to seek forgiveness and to share with their families how God has touched and changed their lives.



CONNECT - Hand-written letters with powerful messages of hope are written by the inmates themselves. These letters, accompanied by Grocery Vouchers, are hand-delivered by volunteers to their families all across Singapore leading up to the season of Giving.



RECONCILE - This connection of hearts not only brings hope and joy to the families of the inmates, it also opens the door to the reconciliation and restoration of broken relationships between the inmates and their loved ones. This is the true meaning of Christmas.



UNITE - Churches and organisations unite in the spirit of giving towards those who have lesser in the community and caring for those in need. Through the donations and family visitations, many volunteers have experienced the collective impact of this project, not just the families, as recipients.


