



for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

1. Have you ever felt like the "lost sheep" or the "lost coin"? What does the parable of the lost sheep and lost coin in Luke 15, say about how God sees people who feel far from Him?

Reflection: Think about times when you felt disconnected, overlooked, or spiritually adrift. How does it change your view to know that God actively seeks you out with love, not condemnation?

2. Why do you think Jesus told these stories to people who were judging Him for spending time with "sinners"? What does this reveal about who is welcome in God's kingdom?

Reflection: Are there barriers—internal or external—that make you feel like you're not worthy of God's love? What do these parables say about who Jesus came for?


3. Jesus says that there is joy in heaven over one sinner who repents. What would it look like for you to "come home" to God today? What step could you take in response to God's invitation?

Reflection: Is there something keeping you from turning back to God? What's stopping you from accepting His love and forgiveness right now?

4. Who in your life seems "too lost" to return? Are you willing to seek out the one, even if it means leaving your comfort?

Reflection: Do you rejoice when someone repents—or do you grumble like the Pharisees?


