QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion
or cell group discussion

- 1. Look with First Century culture lens, not our century's Singaporean specs**
 - Actual amount owed (commission/interest etc added)
 - Obligation of benefactor-recipient- respect/gratitude
- 2. Read carefully what is being said. What was he guilty of?**
 - **DISHONESTY** Possibly a taking big cut from the boss's money
 - **WASTING MASTER'S POSSESSIONS** (perceived laziness but in reality, people couldn't pay the bloated amount, so the boss didn't get the money to invest in something else)
- 3. ACTION:**
 - He righted the wrong.
 - Collected money owed to the boss/ master.
 - Made friends for self
 - Made friends for boss

KEY MESSAGE: Be wise

- I. Use money to strengthen relationships with people**
- II. Use money for God**
- III. It is not too late to act.**

What changes are needed and when do I plan to do them?
- it will cost something (eg for him- lost his 'extras') ...but it is worth it.
