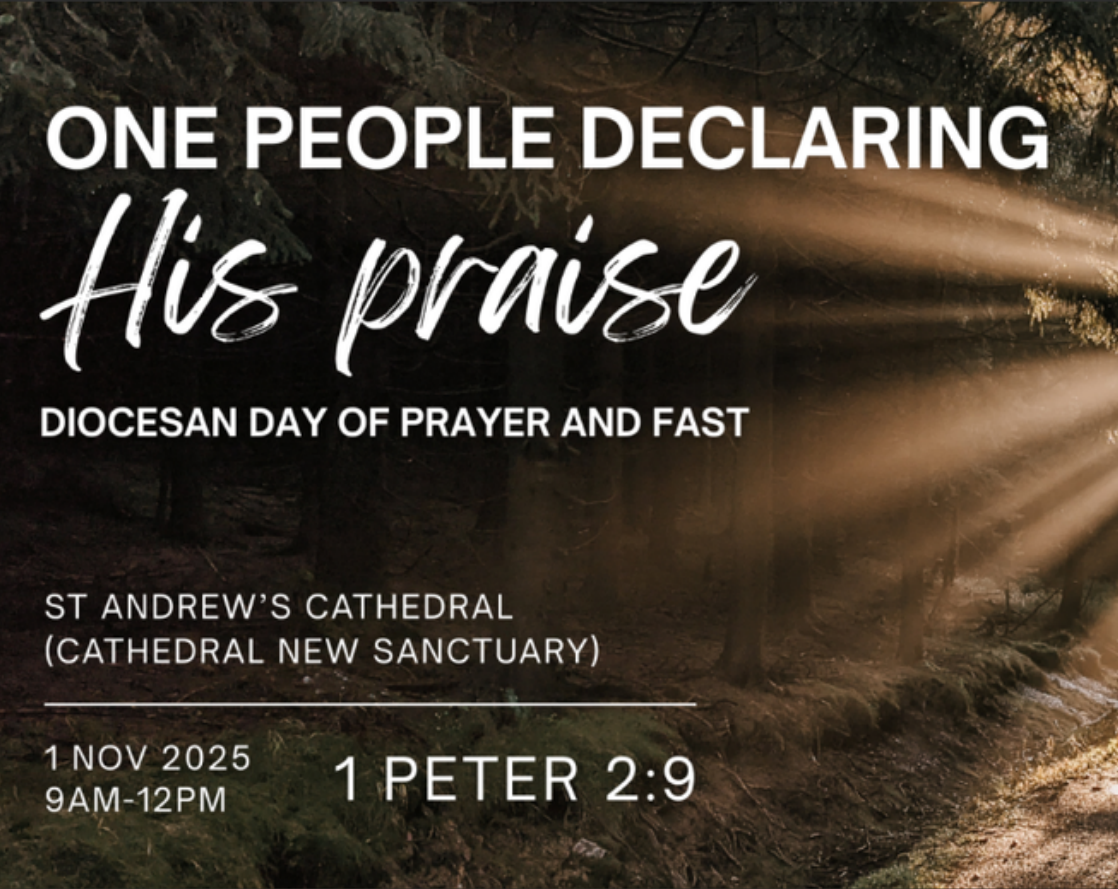

GSFA & PSEA Statements Regarding the Appointment of the New Archbishop of Canterbury

On 3rd October 2025, Rt Revd Dame Sarah Mullally, Bishop of London, was appointed as 106th Archbishop of Canterbury. She will be the first woman to hold this historic office and will be installed at Canterbury Cathedral in March 2026.

While we pray for Bishop Mullally as she takes up this significant role, both the Province of the Anglican Church of South East Asia (PSEA) and the Global South Fellowship of Anglican Churches (GSFA) have expressed reservations about her appointment.

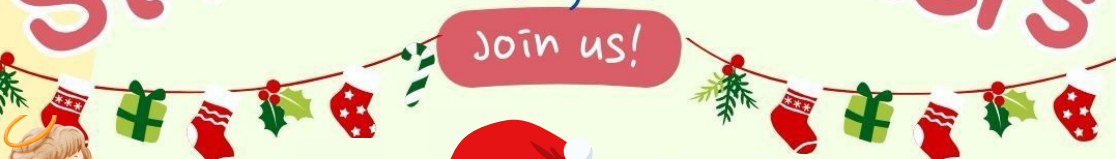
