for individual reflection, family devotion
or cell group discussion

1. With reference to Gal 5:16-25, how does bearing the fruit of the Spirit oppose the fruits of the flesh. Which quality of the fruit of the Spirit are you most lacking in and how can it grow/ripen in your life?
2. How does Jesus' analogy of the vine and the branches in John 15:1-8 convey the significance of abiding in Christ to bearing fruit? God's Word is crucial for us to abide in Christ and to bear fruit (refer to John 15:7, 10, Psalm 1:2-3). What steps can you take to grow in engaging with and obeying God's Word?
3. John 15:1-2 highlights the role of the Father to prune us so that we may bear more fruit. What are some ways the Father can prune us? Share one way you have experienced the Father's pruning in your life and how it has enabled you to bear more fruit.
