1. Jesus' first recorded words in Luke 2:49 reveal His core identity and mission. How does His declaration, "I must be in my Father's house," challenge our common cultural definitions of success, purpose, and family?
2. Growth in wisdom, stature, and favour with God and man (v. 52) is holistic. Which of these four areas do you feel you are growing in? Which one feels stagnant, and what is one step you could take to foster growth there?
3. Psalm 148 calls all creation to worship. How does seeing Jesus as the true "horn of salvation" (Ps. 148:14) whom the Psalm points to, transform your understanding of worship both in your personal and corporate life?

1. Receiving a New Heart

Ezekiel 36 speaks of God giving His people a new heart and placing His Spirit within them. As you begin this new year, what areas of your heart do you sense the Lord wanting to renew, soften, or realign by His Spirit? Share honestly with each other.

2. Walking Daily in the Spirit

Jesus breathed on His disciples and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit,” empowering them to live and serve courageously. What does walking “by His Spirit” look like for you in your daily life this year — at home, at work, or in your relationships? What might need to change in how you listen, respond, or obey?

3. Joining God’s Mission Together

The Spirit is given not only for personal renewal but for God’s mission through His people. As St. Paul’s Church enters its 90th year, how do you sense the Holy Spirit calling you and/or your cell group — to participate in God’s mission in this next season? Consider practical ways your group can respond together.

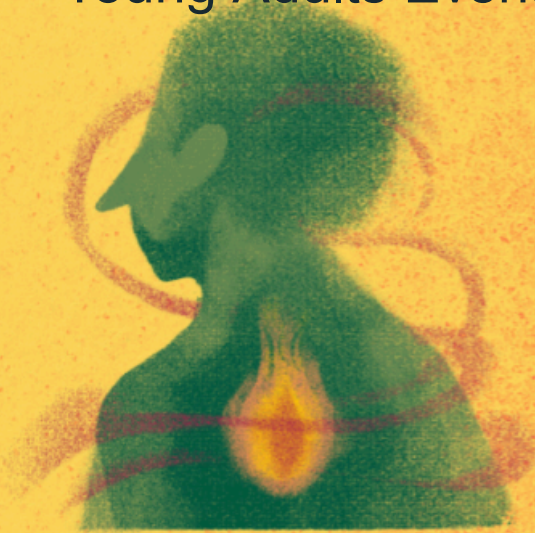
