- * If your life is threatened as a follower of Jesus Christ, what is your response?**

Read Acts 6:8-15:

1. What do you learn about Stephen and what qualities of Stephen is reflected in yours?
2. Read Acts 7:54-60. What do you discover about Stephen's character in this section?
3. Acts 7:55–56 shows that Stephen fixed his eyes on God even in the most extreme circumstances. When you face challenges, opposition, stress, or discouragement, where are your eyes fixed? What tends to occupy your attention first—fear, the need for control, self-preservation, or Christ—and why?
4. In Acts 7:59–60, Stephen prayed, “Lord, do not hold this sin against them.” How does the Holy Spirit shape your response to those who have hurt you? What would it look like, practically and prayerfully, for you to entrust justice to Christ and respond with forgiveness formed by the Holy Spirit?
5. In Acts 7: 59, Stephen prayed, “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.” What does it mean for you to entrust your life fully to Jesus? Which areas in your life do you find a challenge to pray and submit fully like Stephen.” How do you plan to break these challenges?
