Today's Sermon

The Leading of the Holy Spirit for Personal Evangelism

Acts 8 : 26-40 Revd Dr. Lewis Lew

QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

* **Do you see yourself as an evangelist: Share and explain.**

Read Acts 8:1-25:

1. How is it significant that Philip, a Jew went to Samaria? (v.5)

Read Acts 8:26-40

2. What were the factors that contributed to the Ethiopian eunuch converting/becoming a Christian and what role did Scripture play in the eunuch's conversion. What principles of evangelism do you see in this passage. Share your thoughts.
3. Philip left a massive and successful revival in Samaria because of a single nudge from the Holy Spirit to go to the barren desert (Acts 8:26).

Discussion: Why is it hard for us to follow the Spirit's leading? Share a time when you felt a "nudge" that didn't make logical sense at the time.

What happened?

4. The Spirit told Philip to "stay near" the chariot (Acts 8:29). This required Philip to be physically present and spiritually alert to the Eunuch who was from a different culture and background.

Discussion: What does "staying near" to the chariot looks like, in your workplace, neighbourhood, or school this week without being "preachy" and "pushy"?

5. Philip didn't force the sermon on the Eunuch; he started with where the man was.

Discussion: How can we improve our attentiveness in evangelism to find out where a person is, in his/her life (hurts, questions, or interests)?

If a friend says to you, "*I feel like life is just a series of random, meaningless events.*" Where do you think the person is, and how will you use that opportunity to point the person towards Christ Jesus?

* **What have you learned from this passage that might help you become a more effective witness?**


