Thirst, Testing and True Water

Exodus 17 : 1-7, John 4 : 5-26

QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or
cell group discussion

1. Reflective Question — Thirst

Both Israel in the wilderness and the Samaritan woman at the well experienced deep thirst.

In our own life, what are the “wells” you tend to turn to when you feel empty, anxious, or uncertain? How does Jesus’ offer of “living water” challenge or reshape where you seek satisfaction?

(Purpose: personal reflection and honest sharing about misplaced trust or spiritual longing.)

2. Discussion Question — Testing

In Exodus 17 the people questioned, “Is the Lord among us or not?” Yet God still provided water.

Think about a time when you experienced a “wilderness” season — a time of testing or uncertainty.

Looking back, how did that season reveal what you were trusting in, and how did you see God’s grace at work?

(Purpose: helps the group connect testing with God’s initiative of grace.)

3. After meeting Jesus, the Samaritan woman left her jar and went to tell others.

What might it look like for us this week to share the “living water” we have received?


