### QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

#### 1. **Owners of the donkey(s): Those who promised.**

Yes means YES. (is my Yes really YES?)

Yes means NOW (do I procrastinate my promise of commitment?)

God doesn't shortchange (Assurance!)

#### 2. **The people:**

a. Those who were expectant and those with hardened hearts (Leaders) Don't condemn those who are hungry, Examine self for hardening because of disappointments, cynicism, pride

b. (Crowd) Beware of fixation to an expected outcome: be open to His way

#### 3. **The moneychangers, sellers and religious leaders:**

CALL FOR REPENTANCE :Live out what you believe. No sham.

- Stop exploitation/oppression

- Stop exclusion of the seekers

- Stop doing these under cover of "faith" **Check out our social principles / Christian social positions**

- **Are we following it? If not - REPENT!**

*Mr Stanley Tay*

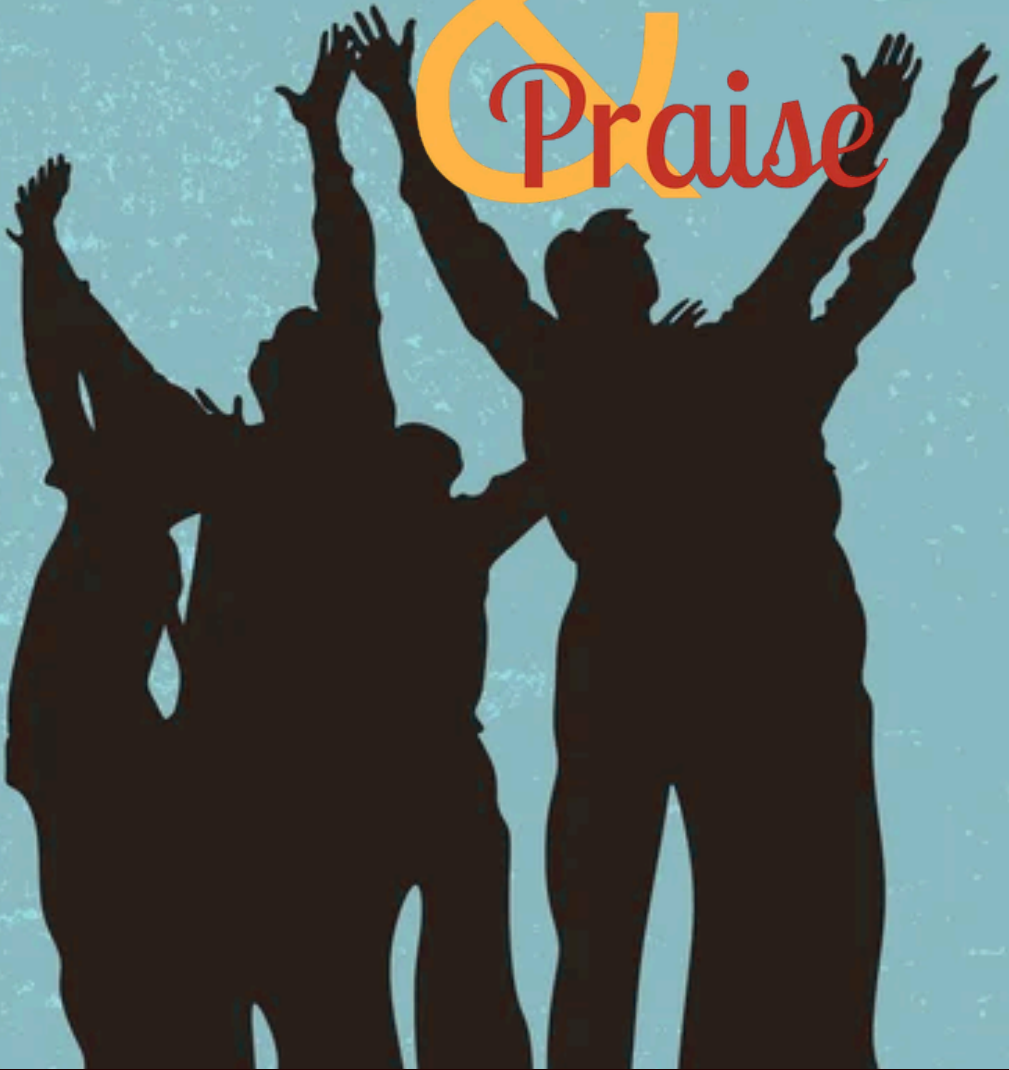
