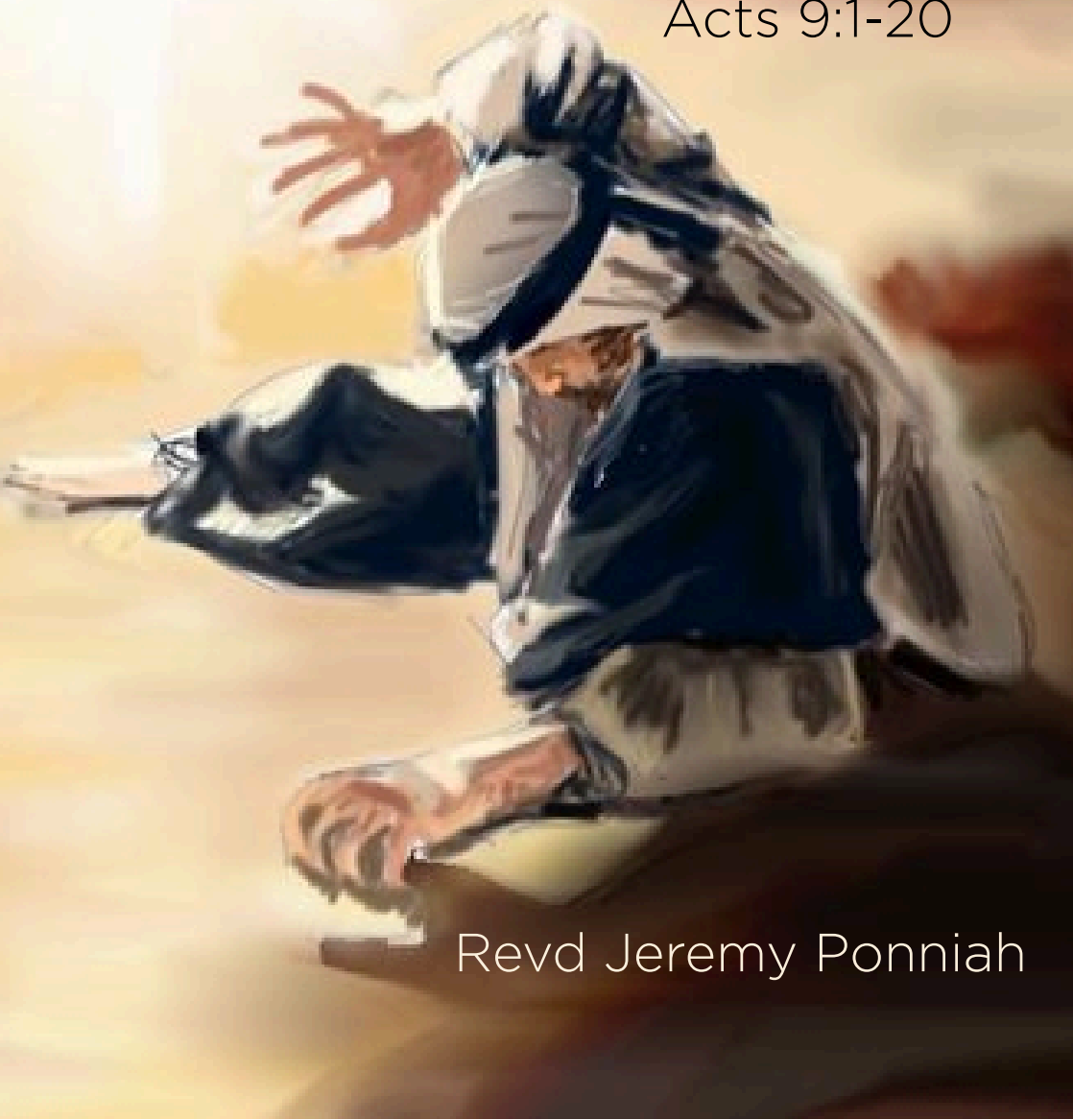
2. Grace and Discipleship (John 21)
