1. Faithfulness under pressure

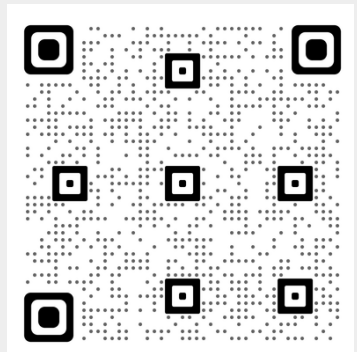

Parents will need to:

- 1. Submit Form A for the Vicar's or authorised person's endorsement by Sunday, 24 May in person with the following supporting documents (to):**
 - a) Child / Ward's Birth Certificate
 - b) Parent/s Confirmation & Baptism Certificate/s
- 2. With the endorsed Form A, submit it together with other necessary documents as indicated on the MOE website when Phase 2B is launched on the dates indicated. Submission is to be made through the FormSG using the SingPass.**

Criteria for Phase 2B

- For a child who is a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident, and born between 2 January 2020 and 1 January 2021 (both dates inclusive). Foreign students are not eligible for Phase 2B Registration.
- Whose parent has joined the primary school as a parent volunteer not later than 1 July of the year before P1 registration and has given at least 40 hours of voluntary service to the school by 30 June of the year of P1 registration.
- **Whose parent is a member endorsed by the church or clan directly connected with the primary school.**
- Whose parent is endorsed as an active community leader.
