QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or
cell group discussion

1. Gideon saw himself as weak and inadequate.
What fears or insecurities most often stop us from obeying God or trusting Him fully today?
Reflection Areas:
fear of failure, / fear of rejection, / fear about the future, / comparison with others, / feelings of inadequacy.
2. "The Spirit of the LORD clothed Gideon." (Judges 6:34)
What does it practically mean today to depend on the Holy Spirit rather than relying only on our own strength?
Reflection Areas:
prayer, / surrender, / courage, / obedience, / daily dependence, / spiritual discernment, / responding faithfully despite fear.
3. What lessons can we learn from the event recorded in Judges 6:25-27 that occurs between Gideon's call (Judges 6:14) and being clothed by the Spirit (Judges 6:34) to accomplish victory over the Midianites?

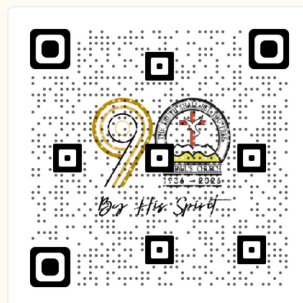

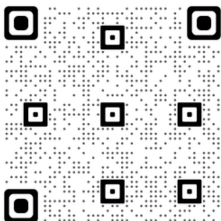
