QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or
cell group discussion

1. Before Jesus began His public ministry, the Father declared, "This is my beloved Son." Many people today base their identity on achievement, success, or approval from others. What practical steps can help us root our identity more deeply in God's love rather than in performance or comparison?
2. Isaiah 61 describes people who are broken-hearted, weary, and burdened. Who are the "broken-hearted" and "captives" around us today, and how might the Holy Spirit be calling us to bring Christ's hope and compassion to them?
3. Jesus came to bring good news to the spiritually poor, heal the broken hearted, and set captives free. Where do you most need to experience Christ's healing, freedom, or grace today? Are there burdens, wounds, or sins that you need to bring honestly before Him?
4. The Spirit-anointed Messiah transforms ashes into beauty, mourning into joy, and despair into praise. As you consider your present struggles, where do you need to trust God's ongoing work of restoration? How can the promise of Christ's final victory strengthen your hope and perseverance this week?

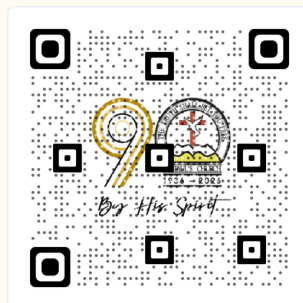

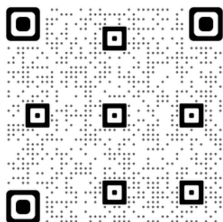
