#### 1. Living Between Having and Being Filled

We heard that it is possible to have the Holy Spirit and yet not be living filled by the Spirit.

Where do you see this gap in your own life right now?

#### 2. Evidence of the Spirit in Ordinary Life

Paul says a Spirit-filled life is seen in speech, gratitude, and relationships (Ephesians 5:19–21).

Which of these areas most reflects your current spiritual condition — and which needs growth?\*

#### 3. Theological & Life-Application Question

In Ephesians 5:18–21, being “filled with the Spirit” results in worship, gratitude, and submission in relationships.

What does it practically mean to “be filled” rather than merely “have” the Spirit in your daily decision-making and relationships?

Recall a recent moment where you acted quickly—what might have changed if you had paused and yielded to the Spirit instead?

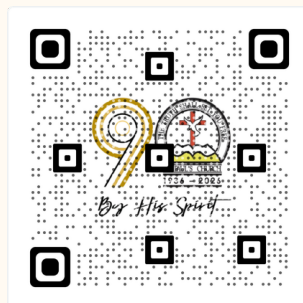

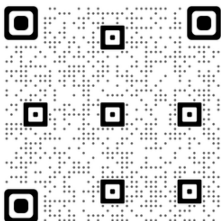

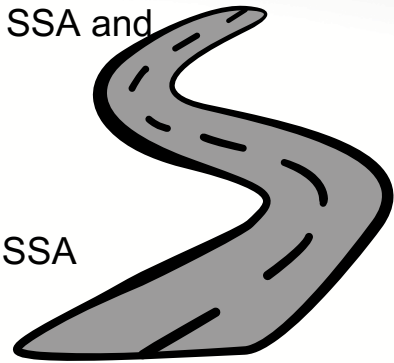
