

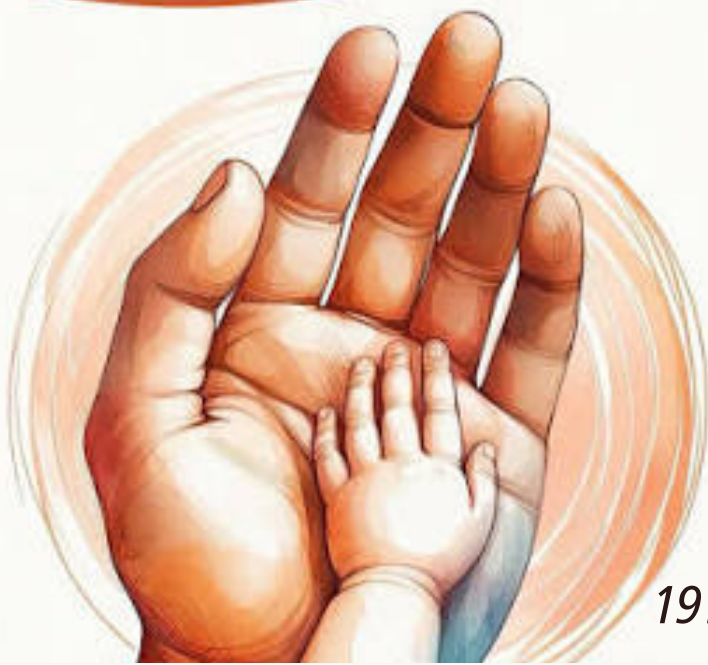

QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

1. Identity: Living as God's Children

Paul says, "All who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God" (Romans 8:14).

Question: In practical terms, what does it mean to be led by the Holy Spirit rather than by our own desires, fears, ambitions, or circumstances? Can you share an area of your life where you sense the Spirit calling you to greater obedience?

2. Suffering: Living in a World of Wheat and Weeds

Jesus teaches that wheat and weeds will grow together until the harvest, while Paul reminds us that creation itself is groaning as it waits for redemption.

Question: How does knowing that we live in a world where wheat and weeds coexist help us understand suffering, injustice, disappointment, and unanswered questions in our own lives?

How should Christians respond differently from the world when faced with these realities?

3. Hope: Awaiting God's Final Victory

Paul writes that "our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us" (Romans 8:18).

Question: What future hope does God promise His children, and how can that hope shape the way we live, serve, pray, and persevere today while we await the final harvest and the fullness of God's Kingdom?

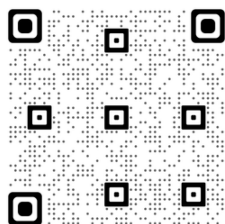
