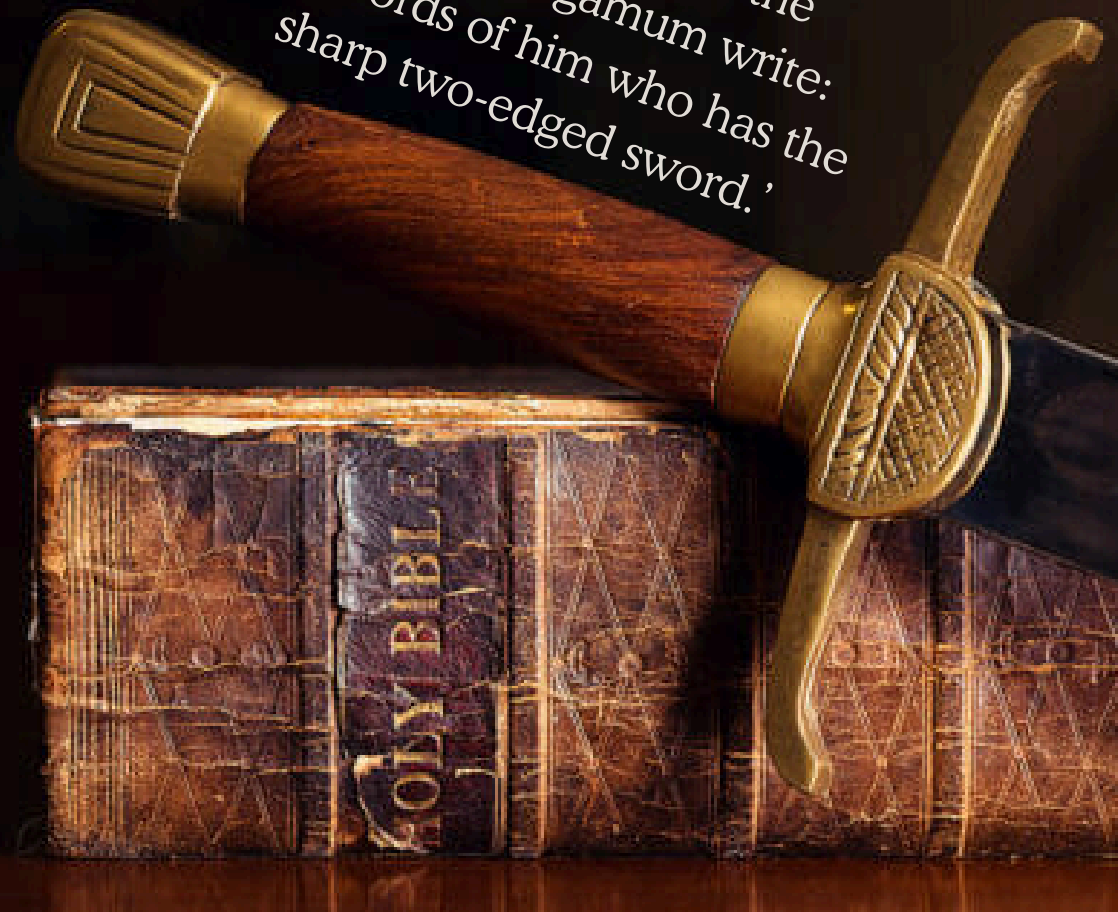

QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

1. Living in a multi-racial and multi-religious society where there is freedom of worship unlike the persecuted church in Pergamum, how can we hold fast to our faith and not be influenced by the practices and beliefs of our non-Christian community, friends or family members? What practical steps can we take to be the “salt and light” in the community we live in?
2. How can we as a church guard against the teachings of Balaam (namely greed, covetousness, eating food sacrifices to idols, sexual immorality) and the Nicolaitans (namely, heretical teachings e.g. salvation by grace alone) from creeping in and influencing the lives of God's people?
3. How should we be preparing ourselves individually in taking heed of the Spirit's warning to the church and making sure that we will receive the rewards that Jesus promises us when He returns?
