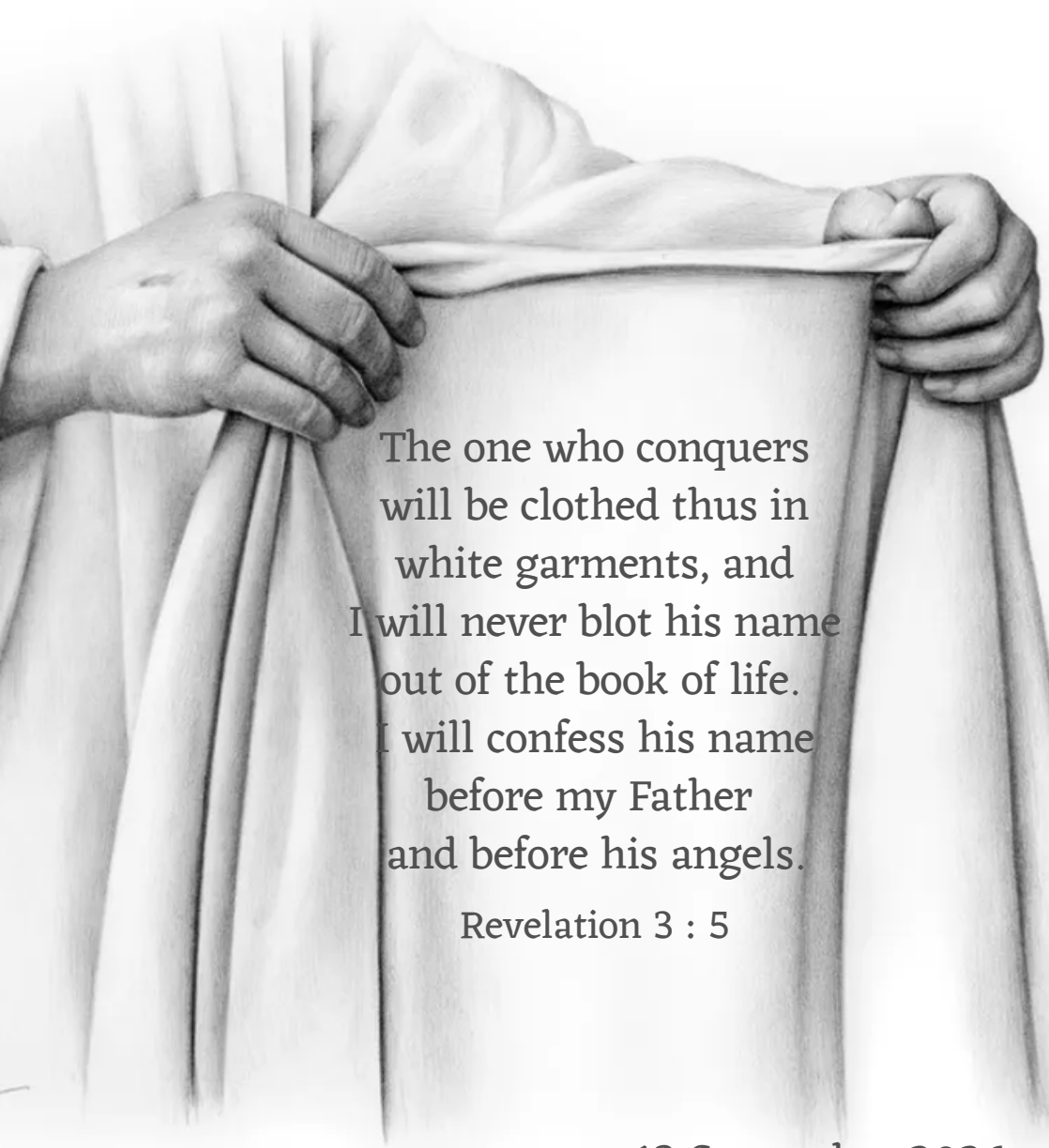

QUESTIONS

for individual reflection, family devotion or cell group discussion

- I. ***Which is the most jialat (terrible / in deep trouble) church in the book of Revelation?***
- II. ***What we know about SARDIS: Distinguished, famous, rich, prospered after setbacks (earthquake, conquered). Has large Jewish community. The Church was active, big, growing, well respected. It was not under persecution, it had no big theological conflicts or immoral scandals. Seen as doing very well.***
- III. ***From God's perspective: The church had.***
 1. A reputation of being alive but was dead and dying.
His Message: WAKE UP! Things are not well. Deal with inner motivations and sins.
 2. Had deeds unfinished.
His Message: REMEMBER! The gospel is not only about going to heaven (escaping judgement) but there is a bigger calling: a. growing in holiness ('dying to self and living for Christ') and b. working to transform His world ("Thy Kingdom Come!") . Act on it NOW (not just hear but obey)
 3. Had soiled their clothes: not victorious over sin.
His Message: REPENT! As individuals and as Church, we have compromised in life and in values. It's serious sins. Change now. Do right.
