1. The present writ petition has been preferred by the petitioners against the communication dated 03.02.2025 issued by the learned District Collector, Jaisalmer whereby objections were



invited in relation to the land in question which was proposed to be allotted to respondent No.6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that till date, no decision has been taken by the District Collector, Jaisalmer pursuant to the communication dated 03.02.2025. He further submits that the petitioners are in possession of the land which is proposed to be allotted to respondent No.6 and they have also preferred a revenue suit seeking declaration.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners makes a limited prayer that he may be permitted to submit his objections before the District Collector, Jaisalmer and the District Collector, Jaisalmer may be directed to consider the objections as submitted by the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Collector, Jaisalmer to consider the objections to be filed by the petitioners strictly in accordance with law.

5. Needless to observe that if the objections have already been decided and allotment process has been concluded, then no adjudication would be required on the objections to be submitted by the petitioners.

6. All pending applications stand disposed of.
