ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the appellant has apprised us that the notices which were sent to him to be served upon the respondents could be received yesterday only by him in the evening, therefore, prior to their receipt, he served notices to respondents on his own through e-mail but not dasti.

2. Today, from amongst the respondents, only respondent no. 2- Captain of Ports Department is being represented by learned counsel Mr. Shubham Sinai Priolkar and he states that he has received copy of memo of Appeal with delay although copies of the interim application for stay and delay condonation have been received by him with adequate time to respond and has sent us reply thereto yesterday but we do not find the same to have been restored on record by the Registry.

3. It is apprised by the Registry that today because of server being down, the affidavit could not be printed.

4. It is also apprised by the Registry that there is an e-mail received from the appellant accompanied with service affidavit but print out of the same could not be obtained.

5. In view of the admission made by the learned counsel for the appellant that he could not effect service upon all the respondents as the notices sent by Registry could be received with delay, we direct the Registry to issue fresh notices to the appellant to be effected on all respondents except respondent no. 2 who has already put in appearance, returnable within four weeks.

6. Learned counsel for respondent no. 2 has apprised us that the dredging activity has already been completed.

7. Put up this matter for next consideration on 07.04.2026.
