Sealed Bids for the construction of the City of Roselle – Goose Lake Park Path Replacement will be received by the Roselle Park District at Clauss Recreation Center, 555 W. Bryn Mawr Ave, Roselle, IL 60172, until 10:00 a.m. local time on Thursday, May 21, 2026, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted until the specified opening time and date. All bids must be checked in by the Roselle Park District's office prior to bid time. Any bidder attempting to deliver after the opening time and date will be refused.

The project consists of reconstructing the existing trail within Goose Lake Park. Project includes HMA surface removal full depth, sidewalk removal, aggregate base course, type B 9", HMA surface course, - 3", Geotextile fabric, WINFAB315W Woven, erosion control, earthwork, site restoration, staking, aggregate base course, type B 6", guardrail.

This project is funded in-part by an Illinois Department of Natural Resources Recreational Trail Program grant. As such this project is required to adhere to the rules, regulations, and statutes of the grant program, including: the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.), the Endangered Species Protection Act, 520 ILCS 10/11; section 17 of the Illinois Natural Areas Preservation Act, 525 ILCS 30/17; the mitigation or compensation determinations required by the Interagency Wetland Policy Act, 20 ILCS 830/1 et seq.; the environmental and economic impact determination required by the Historic Preservation Act, 20 ILCS 3420/4, the Land Trust/Beneficial Interest Disclosure Act (765 ILCS 405/2.1), the Steel Products Procurement Act (30 ILCS 565 et seq.), the Workers' Compensation Insurance, Social Security, Retirement and Health Insurance Benefits, and Taxes, and the Build America Buy America Act, Section 70914 of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (also known as the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act), P.L. 117-58, on or after May 14, 2022.

A pre-construction conference **will** be held for this project at the Mensching Road Park entrance near the playground at Goose Lake Park at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2026.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

Roselle Park District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by Roselle Park District for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids.

The Work of this Project is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq. The Contract entered into for the Work will be drawn in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide for payment of all laborers, workmen, and mechanics needed to perform the Work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages (including the prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work as applicable) for each craft, type of worker, or mechanic.

The Contractor(s) selected will also be required to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations and executive orders, including but not limited to those pertaining to equal employment opportunity.
