



**Please keep in mind the following builder guidelines:**

**All houses must be delivered to the Beveridge Pavilion  
April 30th or May 1st, 2026 between 3:00 pm - 5:00 pm**



**Use natural materials that are already on the ground, please don't pick flowers or leaves to be used and avoid invasive species such as bittersweet! Materials you should use are:**

dry grasses, leaves, sticks, pebbles, shells, bark from a fallen tree, milkweed pods, acorns, berries, gourds, miniature pumpkins, pinecones are a few examples. Get creative and make little beds, tables or chairs out of sticks or clay.

**All fairy houses must appear to be made entirely of natural components.**

Hot glue, acrylic spray, natural twine and other man-made items can be used but must be completely concealed by natural elements.

**Houses should be tabletop size and portable. Maximum dimensions of 2ft wide x 2ft high** are recommended. We will accept larger houses and on-site building on a case-by-case basis.

**Platforms or man-made support materials should be used** for easier delivery and transport but must be concealed with natural materials when installed on-site. Please use a sturdy base that can hold up if wet (such as plywood or luan). We will have tree rounds that can be picked up at the Park if needed for the base.

**Please do not use any items of value in the house** as Stanley Park does not take any responsibility for any loss or damage.

**The theme of the house can be anything you wish. Let your inspiration flow and be creative like fairies are!**

**You can come get your house any time after the fairy walk ends on  
Sunday, May 3, 2026 at 2:00 pm.**

**All houses not retrieved by May 10th or they will magically disappear!**
