Afterward, take a boat to the village for a walking tour. Here, you learn about the significant conservation efforts developed to protect sea turtles that come to nest here each year. Tonight, meet with your Tour Manager before dinner at the lodge

DAY 3, Monday, April 19 - Explore Tortuguero

Awaken this morning to the sounds of the jungle. A boat takes you through remote, unspoiled sections of the park's waterways on the winding canals, where you're likely to see turtles, caimans, monkeys, and many colorful tropical birds. After lunch, acquaint yourself with the many tree and insect species of Costa Rica on an easy guided hike through trails in the nearby rainforest. Dinner is at the lodge

DAY 4, Tuesday, April 20 - Travel to Arenal

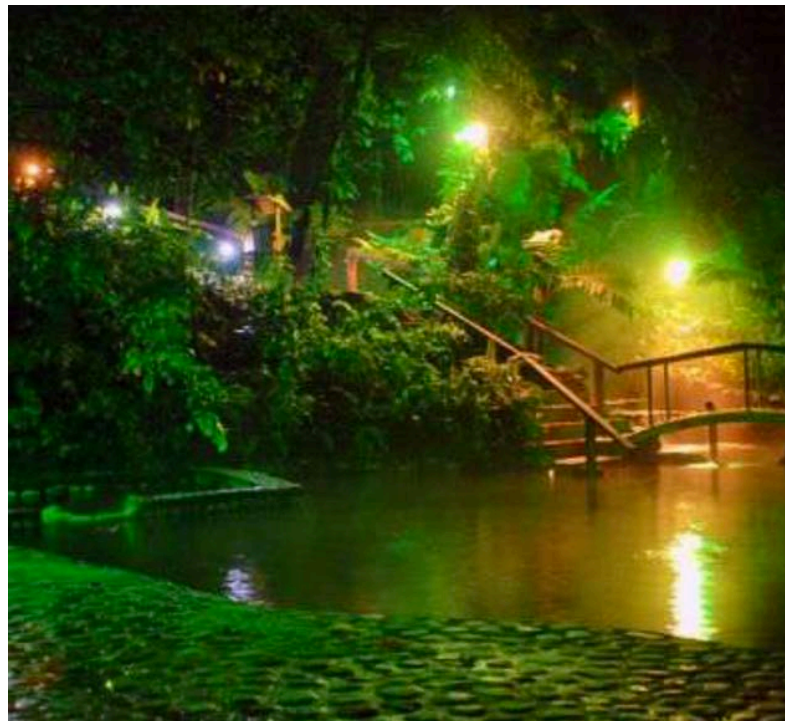
DAY 5, Wednesday, April 21 -

Cano Negro, Eco Termales Hot Springs with dinner

Spend the day on a boat tour down the Rio Frio, and learn about the flora and fauna endemic to the area. Tonight you will relax in the renowned Hot Springs of Arenal. The family-owned EcoTermales has four different pools, ranging in temperature from 91 to 105 degrees Fahrenheit, surrounded by the local flora of the forest. Private and secluded, these hot springs are a great way to wind down after a long day of sightseeing. While there, enjoy an included traditional Costa Rican dinner.

DAY 6, Thursday, April 22 - Arenal National Park, Travel
 to Monteverde, Monteverde Brewery Tour with Dinner
 In the morning, embark on a brisk two-mile hike in Arenal National Park to learn more about the flora and fauna of the area. Admire views of the volcano (weather permitting) before continuing to Monteverde. Tonight, take a tour of the Monteverde Brewery and go behind-the-scenes to discover the hidden world of Monteverde's craft beer. The secret lies in the quality of the water, which is rich in minerals, sourced directly from the Monteverde cloud forest. After the tour, receive a glass as a souvenir and savor a delicious dinner.

DAY 7, Friday, April 23 - Full Day in Monteverde, Selvatura Hanging Bridges
 This morning, enjoy a walk among the treetops on this 1.9-mile trail, which boasts 8 different bridges at heights ranging from 36 to 180 feet. The Selvatura Hanging Bridges are the longest and strongest bridge system in the country. The hanging bridges give you the unique opportunity to see plants and animals not visible from the ground. This afternoon have lunch and take a tour of a traditional Costa Rican coffee farm. Learn about how one of Costa Rica's top exports is grown in this tropical region and its importance in the socioeconomic development of the country. This evening, savor dinner in Monteverde

DAY 8, Saturday, April 24 - Sarchí, Travel to San Jose
 Travel back to San Jose today. En route stop in Sarchí, a charming artisan town in Costa Rica's Alajuela province, widely renowned as the "cradle of Costa Rican handicrafts" and famous for its giant, brightly painted wooden oxcarts (carretas). Returning to San Jose, a city tour is planned prior to dinner.

Trip Cancellation, Trip Interruptions & Trip Delay

Provides reimbursement for unused, non-refundable trip cost. Trip Interruption also provides reimbursement for additional transportation costs. Trip Delay provides coverage if you are delayed during a trip for more than 8 hours.

Some examples of covered reasons are listed below. See plan for full details.

- Your, a Family Member's, or a Traveling Companion's Sickness, accidental injury or death
- Being hijacked, quarantined, subpoenaed, or asked to serve on jury duty
- Home or destination is made uninhabitable
- Traffic accident en route to departure
- Death or hospitalization of host at destination
- Terrorist attack

Missed Connection

Provides reimbursement if You miss Your Trip departure because Your arrival at Your Trip destination is delayed for 3 or more hours, due to:

- any delay of a Common Carrier;
- documented weather condition preventing You from getting to the point of departure for Your Trip.

Baggage and Personal Effects

Provides reimbursement of Baggage or other personal effects that are lost, damaged or stolen while on your trip.

Baggage Delay

Provides coverage for the emergency purchase of essential items if your Baggage is delayed for more than 12 hours during your trip.

Medical Expense
