

Base Membership Policies

- Memberships are Non-Transferable – Only named members may use the membership
- A Base Membership consists of 2 Adults and 2 Children. Additional members may be added for \$30 per person. All members must reside at the same address.
 - Children must be related to adults on membership.
 - Grandparents may purchase membership for grandchildren not living at their same residence.
 - Caregivers may be added as Add-On Adult member.
- Membership includes 2 one-time use guest passes. These can be used for any additional guests not on the membership (1 guest pass used per person).
 - Guest passes expire when the membership expires and do not roll over if the membership is renewed.
- Membership year begins with date of membership purchase and expires at the end of the calendar year. *Ex. Purchased on January 5, 2026, Expires on December 31, 2026.*
- New memberships may apply ticket purchase price to their fee if purchased on the same day while at the Lab.
 - Only one receipt may be applied towards purchase of membership.
 - May only apply as many tickets as there are members towards the membership purchase.
 - Credit card payments: A second charge will appear on the patron's payment information for the balance of the membership fee.
- Children who have turned 2 years old, and/or any qualifying adults may be added at any time during the membership year.
 - Fees are not prorated.
 - Expiration date does not change.
- Membership fees may not be applied towards group visits, field trips, birthday parties, and/or special programs such as workshops, classes, or camps – however, member discounts do apply.
- Adult members are required to show a valid photo ID for every entry.
- Digital cards are emailed 7 days after purchase. If you do not receive your cards after 7 days, please contact our membership team at membership@childsci.org.
- Reciprocity with 2 museum networks is included with your membership. Be sure to visit the websites to see which museums are included and their restrictions.
 - Association of Science and Technology Centers (ASTC) – Members receive free family admission access to centers participating in their Travel Passport program (outside a 90-mile radius). Please visit <https://www.astc.org/membership/find-an-astc-member/passport/> for a list of participating museums and each museum's individual restrictions.
 - Association of Children's Museums (ACM) – Members receive 50% off admission (up to 6 tickets) at children's museums participating in ACM Reciprocal Network. Please visit <https://findchildrensmuseum.org/> for participating museums.
- Members that reserve tickets to one of our timed entry sessions but do not either call or email prior to the start of the event to cancel, will be considered a "No Show". After 3 No Shows, a member is no longer able to reserve timed entry tickets in advance. They may still be granted entry as a "walk-up" if space permits. Museums for All Membership Policies

- Memberships are Non-Transferable – Only named members may use the membership
- A Museums for All Membership consists of up to 2 Adults and all children in the household.
 - Children must be related to adults on membership.
 - Additional adult members may be added for \$5 per person. All members must reside at the same address with the exception of caregivers and grandparents.
- Membership year begins with date of membership purchase and expires at the end of the calendar year. *Ex. Purchased on January 5, 2026, Expires on December 31, 2026.*
- Children who have turned 2 years old, and/or any qualifying adults may be added at any time during the membership year.
 - Fees are not prorated.
 - Expiration date does not change.
- Membership fees may not be applied towards group visits, field trips, birthday parties, and/or special programs such as workshops, classes, or camps – however, member discounts do apply.
- Adult members are required to show a valid photo ID for every entry.
- Digital cards are emailed 7 days after purchase. If you do not receive your cards after 7 days, please contact our membership team at membership@childsci.org.
