



Smoking in Pregnancy Lead

It's an exciting time for Thrive Tribe as we expand our One You Bi-Borough Stop Smoking Services to enhance our hospital maternity settings provision.

We're looking for a **Smoking in Pregnancy Lead** to join our team!

This role will aim to link Thrive Tribe's One You Bi-Borough stop smoking provision with maternity services at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust and make stop smoking support more accessible to pregnant smokers. The aim of this role is to develop and drive forward this partnership, both supporting patients through stop smoking support and working with staff at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust around training, referrals and service familiarisation. You will work to ensure the joint venture is a success and liaise with managers within the local One You Bi-Borough services and key Trust stakeholders to track performance and outcomes.

Like all roles at Thrive Tribe, you can expect your time at work to be fun, varied and challenging. We don't like to stick to a firm JD as we know from experience that things change throughout the lifetime of a role. However, so you know what to expect, here are the initial main duties for this role:

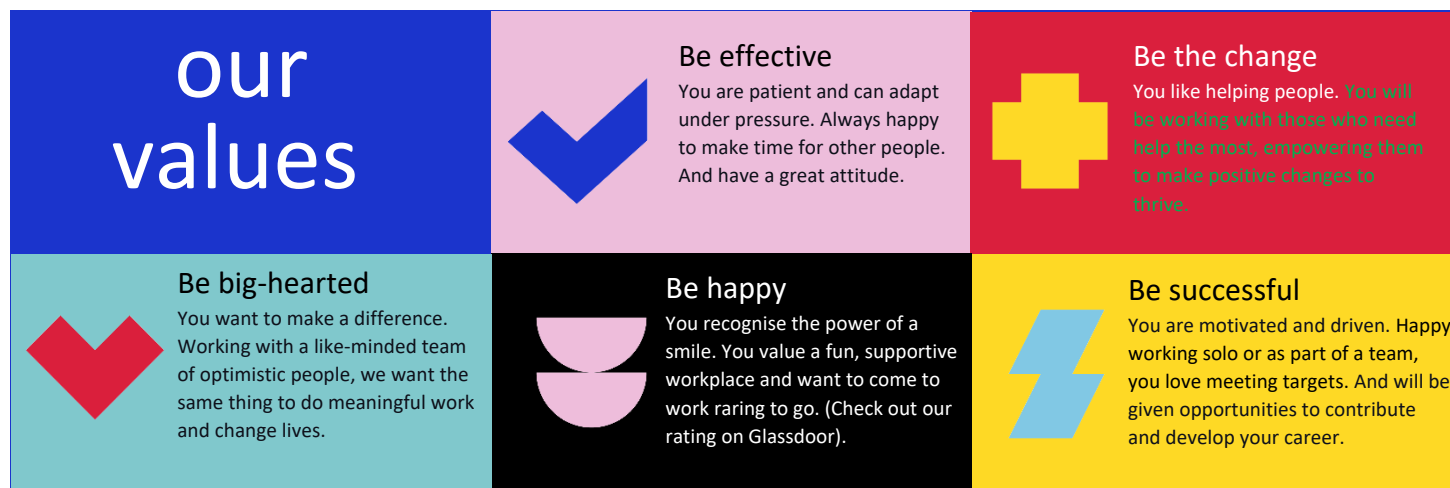
A typical day as a Smoking in Pregnancy Lead might include:

- Helping us maintain the ethos of Thrive Tribe by driving our organisational culture forward across our services and using every opportunity to embed our values!
- To collaborate effectively with key stakeholders and partner organisations, in particular with Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust.
- To provide eligible patients with high quality Stop Smoking interventions, in line with the One You service and NCSCT.
- To signpost patients/eligible family members to the wider One You services and act as liaison between client and local One You practitioners in first instance.
- Promote the use of activity in pregnancy session in The Other Room Virtual Gym.
- Provide smoking cessation patients with vouchers for nicotine replacement therapies (NRT).
- To support the project's referral generation by regularly promoting the One You service to local Trust teams and ensuring staff have good knowledge of referral pathway and eligibility criteria.
- Work with Ante-natal staff to reduce the rate of Smoking at Time of Delivery rates (SATOD).
- Attend strategic events such as the Tobacco Control Meetings to focus on reducing smoking in pregnancy.
- Record all patient contacts and interventions on Thrive Tribe's bespoke patient database (1S4H) used by all delivery areas of the One You services.
- Be responsible for clinical governance in regards to carbon monoxide monitoring and calibration of machinery.
- To record and report activity and ensure targets are met. This includes ongoing analysis of client data to ensure the best outcomes are achieved.

- Lead on the roll out of Making Every Contact Count (MECC) and Ask, Advise and Act to maternity staff (with the support from our local Training Officer).
- Organise the usage of clinic space at Trust's sites.
- To contribute to the growth of Thrive Tribe by working with colleagues across the organisation on service developments, new projects and team building events.
- Ensure due consideration is given to Information Governance and Clinical Governance legislation, requirements and guidance.
- The above list of duties is not exhaustive, a candidate who is adaptable and keen to be involved in new and innovative work streams is desired.

What are we looking for?

- More than anything, we are looking for a team player who puts their heart in to their work. Our core values are very important to us and guide everything we do, so we'd love it if they resonate with you too!



To work with us in this role you will need to have some delivery experience of supporting clients to make healthy lifestyle choices, ideally in the area of smoking cessation. - Experience working with patients in behaviour change setting, ideally in smoking cessation.
- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.

- The ability to project manage multiple work streams and to meet required deadlines.
- An understanding of the world of public health and healthy lifestyle services.
