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Addendum B 2025 LQAC Lake Goals

LQAC Lake Goals by section for 2025:

Mountain View Consulting Group is how most of the goals are implemented, and achieved

Watershed Jan 2025 - Dec 2025	
1	Continue working on adequate water supply, storage, and access. (LQAC advising BVSA through plan)
2	Evaluate and continue completing the lake shore access improvement project in manageable small pieces. (LQAC)
3	Evaluate and continue lake nursery/habitat area improvement project/ phases. (LQAC)
4	Improve the Surprise Lake drainage that flows from Surprise Lake into Cub Lake for the 2025 drainage improvement project. This project will focus on the last 330' of drainage flowing into Cub Lake. (Drainage improvement planting will be broken into small manageable sections.) (LQAC, BVSA, IGM, CSD)
5	Record, and track evaporative loss rate (LQAC)
6	Continue work on 1st peninsula within Jacks Hole
7	Continue shoreline stabilization using rock rip rap (BVSA, IGM, LQAC)
8	Continue spawning habitat improvement by installing pea gravel spawning beds (BVSA, LQAC)

Water Quality Jan 2025 - Dec 2025	
1	Continue to monitor water quality and evaluate data, improvements, testing, treatments. (LQAC to BVSA)
2	Continue to work with the State of California Water Quality Monitoring Council to report and track Harmful Algae Blooms (HAB)
3	Continue to treat Four Island Lake, and Cub Lake April through October to prevent HAB's, decrease sediment, and maintain vegetation.
4	Evaluate any additional treatments by cost and effectiveness. (LQAC)
5	Track and evaluate all testing associated costs. (LQAC)



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6 Update the Lake Calendar schedule for bacterial and cyanobacteria testing. (LQAC)

5 Incorporate lake educational opportunities for all residents, fishing derbies & virtual fishing photo derby. (LQAC and BVSA)

6 Track and evaluate all fish associated costs and income. (LQAC)

Plants Jan 2025 - Dec 2025

1 Harvest 1/3rd of the 7th Hole Pond lilies and divide the rhizomes that are favorable for multiplying.
Replant all rhizomes into the 7th Hole Pond, Four Island Lake, and Cub lake.(LQAC)

2 Continue to place and grow water hyacinth within the 7th hole pond, and Four Island Lake. In the fall all the growth will be removed. Some of the removed plants will be placed in a greenhouse for the winter to be placed back into the lakes in spring of 2026. (LQAC)

3 Improve the Surprise Lake drainage that flows from Surprise Lake into Cub Lake for the 2025 drainage improvement project. This project will focus on the last 330' of drainage flowing into Cub Lake.
(Drainage improvement planting will be broken into small manageable sections.) (LQAC, BVSA, IGM, CSD)

4 Evaluate and maintain existing floating plant islands. (LQAC)

5 Maintain floating Islands in front of the inlets feeding the lake which have the highest nutrient values.
(LQAC)

6 During the fall Cattail maintenance will be performed around all waterbodies

7 During Spring Maintain Marina Island by weed whacking before Memorial Day weekend.

8 Establish and implement a schedule for maintaining the remaining islands within Four Island and Cub Lake

Recreation, Collaboration, and Partnerships Jan 2025 - Dec 2025

1 Repair the dock access at Cub Lake by filling in the erosion with 1.5" gravel.

2 Obtain a quote to determine the cost of adding an additional dock to Cub Lake to improve recreational fishing access (BVSA)



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3	Attend & provide educational materials at the festivities during Memorial Day, 4th of July-Booth @ Cub Lake, attend and participate in the Boat Parade and paddle races, Labor Day weekend, and Halloween Trunk or Treat. (LQAC)
4	Publicity & Public Awareness. (LQAC and BVSA management)
5	Publicity & Public Awareness to begin informing lake shore property owners and valley residents of the boundary between private property and the lake's common area. As well as explaining the importance and proper use of the common area (BVSA, GM, IGM, Fred)
6	Continue Lake Scholars Program (LQAC)
7	Continue to distribute fish fillets to the BVSA residents (MVCG)
8	Conduct a Lake use survey and compare results to the previous survey conducted in 2020
