Packing List

The following guidelines are to be followed by every participant. Do not hand in this list with your group application. Due to limited space, ALL students & adults are only allowed ONE SUITCASE/BAG & ONE PURSE/BACKPACK!

PACK THIS	 □ Clothing for 9 days (the following are non-negotiable and must be followed): □ LONG shorts (mid-thigh or longer) □ Crew neck T-shirts (may get dirty/ruined, cropped tops prohibited) □ Pants for work projects (old jeans, old gym shorts, etc.) □ Socks & Underwear for 9 days □ 2 pairs of tennis shoes (required for all ministry activities) (if one pair gets soaked, you will have a backup) □ Shower shoes □ Two sets of modest clothing for downtown Chicago □ Travel clothes for the trip to and from Chicago (cropped tops prohibited) □ Modest Pajamas □ Long Sleeves to wear UNDER your ministry shirts on cold/rainy days (this is REQUIRED)
	 □ Bible □ Notebook/Journal & Pen □ Toiletries (Shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, toothbrush & toothpaste, etc.) □ Towels & washcloths (NOT PROVIDED) □ Bedding (NOT PROVIDED) □ Pillow, sleeping bag/sheets/blanket □ A cot or air mattress (if you choose not to bring one, you will be sleeping on a gym floor the entire trip) * SPACE IS LIMITED: If bringing a queen-size air mattress, you will be required to share. ** Beds should only take up ONE space to ensure adequate room for all fellow team members. It will be tight! □ Spending Money (we suggest about \$200) □ Water Bottle
OPTIONAL	Cell phone & charger (Instructions of use will be announced on the trip) Ear pods/headphones (not allowed to have during work projects, VBS, or evening rallies) Flashlight Dirty clothes bag Sunscreen Sunglasses (not allowed during work projects, VBS, or night rallies) Bug repellant Bathing suit (must be modest) & towel if you plan to swim at the lake on free day
PROHIBITED	 Knives (all types and all sizes) Weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms, and spiked jewelry Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, or any paraphernalia associated with drug use Pepper spray/Mace

*Do not bring anything too valuable. If participants do bring valuables, **they are responsible to hide them in their luggage when they are not in use**. Do not leave items lying around unattended.

Clothing

The following clothing guide is for everyone – students and adults, both guys and girls.

All participants not adhering to the guidelines the Outreach leadership has set will be required to change. At all times, modest dress is required! We are representatives of Christ and should provide a great example to those around us. We do not want to bring attention to ourselves but rather to what we are doing.

SHOES	 Open-toed shoes, such as SANDALS (flip flops, camping/hiking style sandals, etc.) ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING WORK PROJECTS, VBS, OR NIGHT RALLIES. This is for your safety. Please wear closed-toed shoes/sneakers. We insist on this and will require you to change.
SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, AND JACKETS	 Modest shirts must be worn at all times - for both guys and girls! Shirts/t-shirts with sleeves should be worn during all ministry times. Modest tank-tops can be worn during work projects and days off. No tight, see-through, crops or low-cut shirts. Under no circumstances are you allowed to cut off the sleeves of the ministry shirts we provide! Sweatshirts and jackets are allowed ONLY UNDERNEATH ministry shirts if the weather is wet or cold. (Because you are on a mission trip, the people we minister to and the leadership need to be able to identify you by your shirt. We insist on this rule and will ask you to remove your sweatshirt or jacket.)
SHORTS/PANTS	 Shorts must be long enough to cover your butt well, <u>even when bending over</u>. Shorts/pants must also be high enough to cover your underwear <u>even when bending over</u>. <u>Biker shorts are prohibited</u>. Ministry and work projects will have a lot of bending!;) Yoga pants and leggings (with longer shirts) <u>are only acceptable for travel days and the free day</u>.
ACCESSORIES	Bandanas, or headbands that mimic bandanas, are only acceptable for work projects (for sweat control) and are not allowed during ministry times - including as hair accessories.
CHANGING	 Changing must not be done in public areas or areas that are accessible by the other gender. Change in the restrooms/shower area.
WORK CLOTHES	 Bring work clothes! There are a variety of work projects, such as cleaning, lawn care, and painting. Wear clothes you will not care about ruining.

Youth Leader Process

Information for Church Leaders

Requirements:

All youth leaders must be 19 years of age or older for Reach Chicago and have graduated high school by the previous school year (2025-2026).

It is the responsibility of each church to provide adequate leadership for the number of male and female participants they are bringing (see the leader formula below).

Should a church be unable to secure enough leaders from within their church, permission is granted to recruit leaders from another church, Bible College, Chi Alpha, or Master's Commission. However, the burden of recruiting and screening is born solely by the church.

Youth Leader Formula:

The following formula will be used:

0 Leaders	1 Leader	2 Leaders	3 Leaders	4 Leaders	5 Leaders
0 Youth	Up to 6 Youth	Up to 12 Youth	Up to 18 Youth	Up to 24 Youth	Up to 30 Youth

The kitchen staff is not counted in the formulas above. For instance: if you have 6 youth of the same gender and are sending two people to work in the kitchen, you must still provide 1 approved youth leader. All adults wanting to serve as kitchen staff need to contact our administration before registering as kitchen staff.

Your Youth Leaders will be placed on teams with your participants.

TIP: If you have a small number of youth participants (1-3) we recommend contacting another church and partnering your youth together. Please state these arrangements when their forms are submitted with another church to eliminate confusion

Youth Pastor Checklist:

- 1. Receive Leader Applications from your local church volunteers
- 2. Screen each applicant
 - a. Each staff applicant should be screened in accordance with your church volunteer policies as they will be working with your youth.
 - b. A national criminal background check is required to be run on each applicant.
 - Suggested screening resources
 - 1. http://pinnacleprof.com or http://protectmyministry.com specializing in background checks for churches
 - 2. www.checkr.com
 - 3. Your county courthouse
- 3. **Compile a list** of all leaders you approve to work with your youth using the attached Approved Leaders List (below).
- 4. **Include the Signed/Notarized Affidavit:** This lets us know you have appropriately screened each of your leaders and it is required for your leaders to be at Reach Chicago 2026.
- 5. **Remember:** If your church is sending staff serving in the kitchen, they must be screened as well, but do not count as youth leaders for your youth.
