Changing of Bookings


If you wish to change your before or after school care bookings please send us an email or text. We will do our best to accommodate.

Quality Area 1 - Educational Program and Practice



1.1 - Program

Our programming at BPCC is structured to allow each child to succeed and enjoy their time at our centre. We plan our weeks keeping in mind each child's current knowledge, strengths, ideas, abilities and interests.

1.2 - Practice

Our program is developed to facilitate and extend each child's development. Our team responds to children's ideas and play and extend child's learning through interactions and feedback. Each child's agency is promoted, enabling them to make choices and decisions that influence their environment.



1.3 Assessment and Planning

Educators and coordinators plan and reflect on our program and is adapted for the needs of each child. Critical reflection on children's development drives and changes how we plan on a week-to-week basis.
