The Andersons stayed near the hospital to be with him as he spent two weeks in the NICU. **"I'll never forget walking in and seeing this tiny little guy,"** Mindy says. "They just handed him to me to keep feeding him... **It was amazing."**

In the midst of their second adoption, a road trip to Disneyland took an unexpected detour. As they drove through Arizona, Jeannie called: their daughter, Zoey, had arrived, and she was at a hospital just hours away. **The Andersons canceled their vacation and went immediately to meet Zoey.** Mindy remembers feeling an “immediate love and protective side” for her new daughter.

Their third adoption was unique to their first two, as Mindy and Daniel got to meet Ryder’s birth mother. “The love of the birth mom and the sacrifice she’s giving you is humbling,” says Mindy. **“You realize what a gift you are getting.”**

Today, Caleb, Zoey and Ryder fill their home with chaos and love. **“It wasn’t an easy journey,”** Mindy says, **“But I am so grateful we did it.”**
