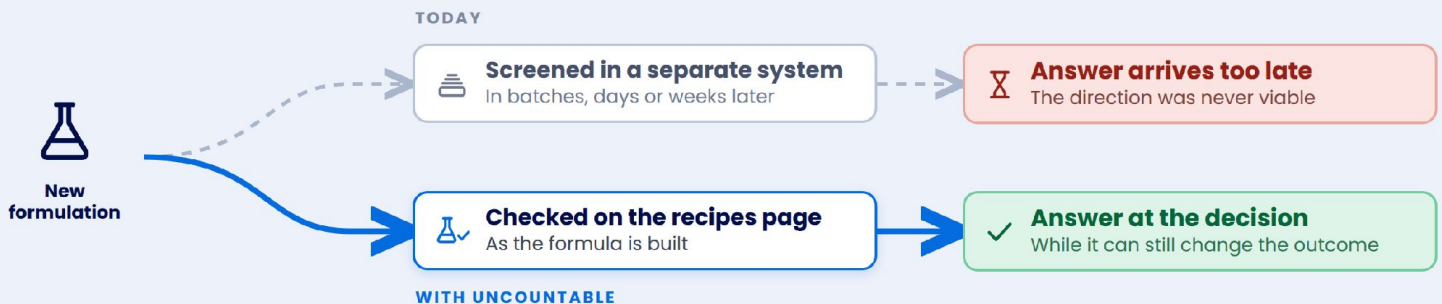

Screening Arrives After the Work Is Done

Regulatory screening usually sits in a separate system, run in batches by someone other than the formulator. Directions that were never viable get developed for weeks, and the answer arrives too late to change what was worth trying in the first place.



What the Formulator Sees



Pass or fail, shown inline

Formulators see the status for every market on the recipes page as they build.



Every row carries its citation

Jurisdiction, product category, permitted level, a pinned link to the official source, and the date it was last checked.



House interpretations that hold

Admins edit or override any row, and re-pulling a source will not overwrite that edit.



Failures can block a release

A failing result can stop a recipe being locked or published. Configurable per workspace.



Every market checked at once

One column per market, so a fail in one market is visible immediately.



The basis is yours to set

Check the recipe as formulated or the finished product, whichever your team uses.

Set by regulatory affairs. Overrides are keyed to the regulation itself, so re-pulling a source does not overwrite them.

Where This Differs From a Screening Tool

The check runs where the work does

Status sits on the recipe being built, rather than in a tool alongside it.

Limits scoped to the product category

A permitted level is matched to what you are making, not to the ingredient alone.

Source text left in its own language

Regulation wording stays verbatim and tagged, so nothing is lost in translation.

Kept up to date for you

Uncountable maintains its own regulations database from official sources, so nobody on your team updates limits manually.
