## Content & educational aims of the youth project

Imagine waking up in a place that doesn't exist on any map – and yet feels more real than the world you left behind.

Welcome to Earthland - a space between timelines, between distraction and clarity, where young people from across Europe come together to explore the big questions of being human amidst the chaos.

Here, stories are told not with words alone but with games, colors, silence, tape, art and maybe the unexpected wisdom of strangers. Each day is a fragment – a spark: a collaborative portrait, a voice whispering your future, a "superpower" you didn't know you had.

Through mindful rituals, wild creativity, and deep listening, Earthland becomes a mirror – for yourself, your community, and the world you want to shape.

## Feedback

There will be daily evaluations to find out about individual feelings, the group atmosphere and the status of the agreed aims of the project. There will also be time and place for criticism and new ideas.

## Social Media

Seminar results, experiences and impressions will be disseminated already during the gathering via social media to present it to a broader public. Networking, transparent education and multiplication are crucial aims. Photos and movies will facilitate only overall impressions.

Portrayal of individuals will only be published if approved beforehand.

## Methods

Non-formal learning methods and digital learning tools. All methods are designed to activate the participants. The methodical repertoire is orientated on the target group and shall support the engagement with the topic.

The aim is that participants will do many things by themselves and that they try things out. It is important to have a high variation of methods to keep the program interesting and exciting and to cover the different needs of all participants (Ice-Breaking, International Country Market night, Virtual Reality experience, Movie Night, Live Action Role Play).

## Working material

You need:

Warm working clothes for working outside (that can get dirty).

Good and sturdy footwear (that can get dirty).

Reusable bottle for water.

Writing and drawing materials for drawing on dry surfaces.

Please bring your own devices with you - tablets and laptops.
