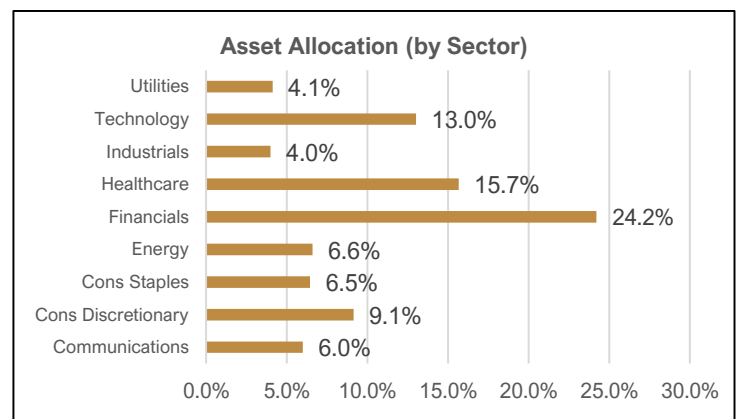
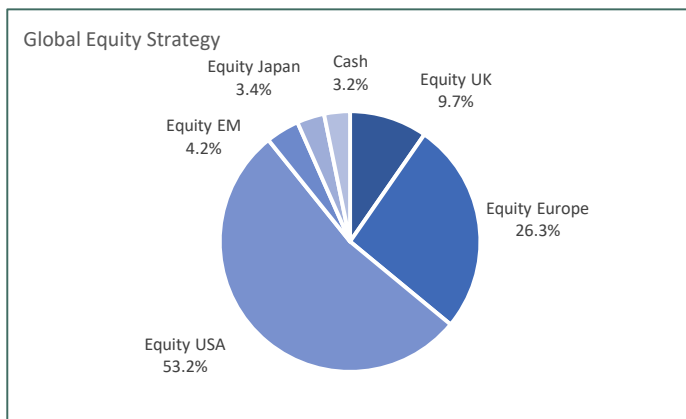
Strategy Description
