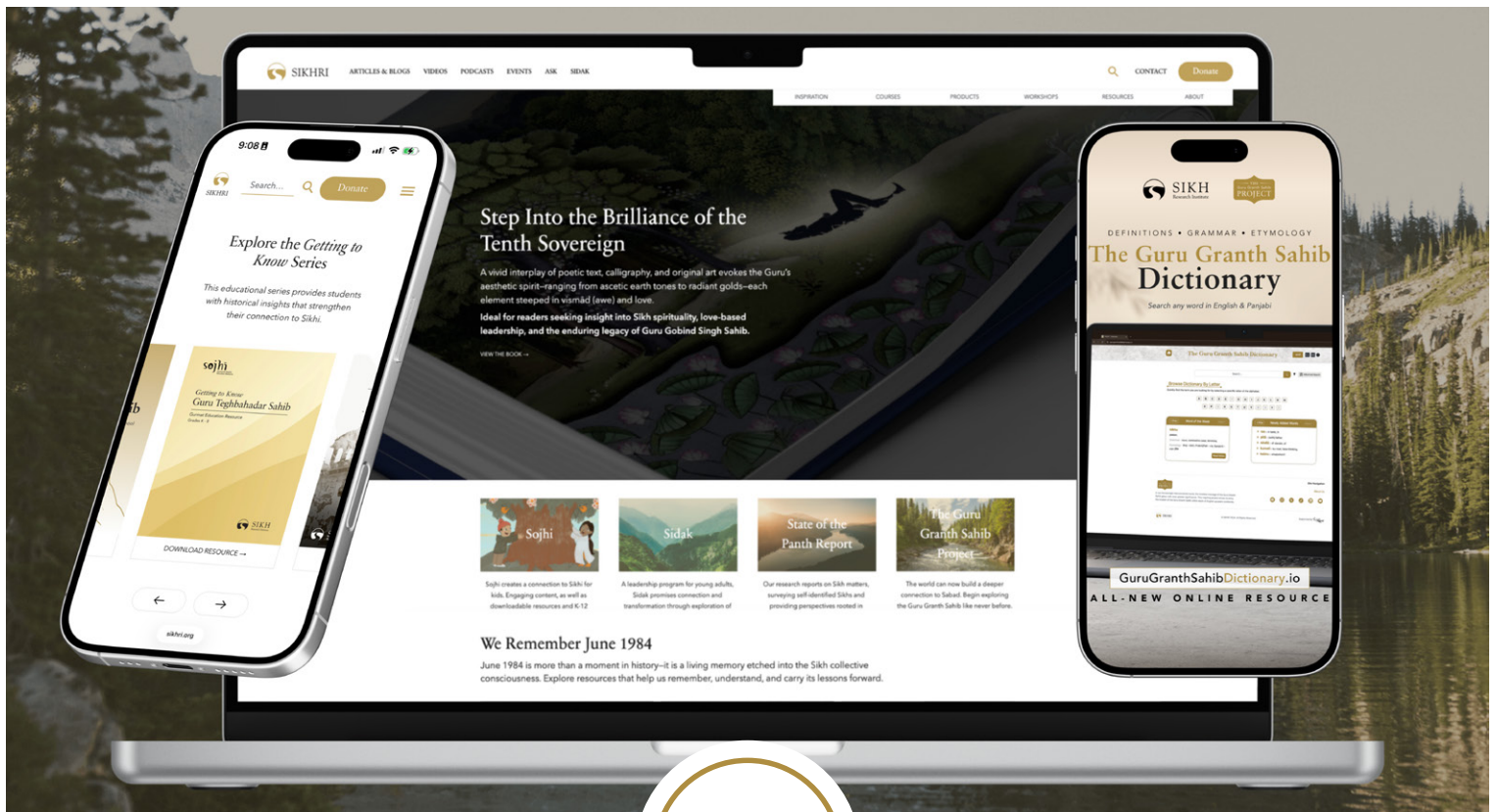

30th Anniversary: Bhai Jaswant Singh Khalsa

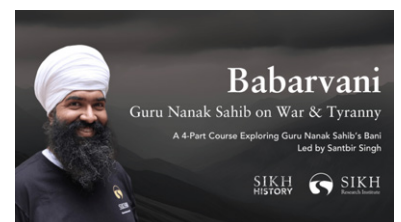

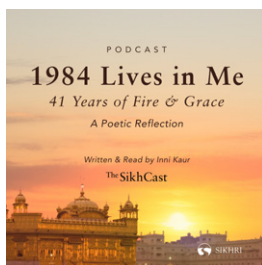
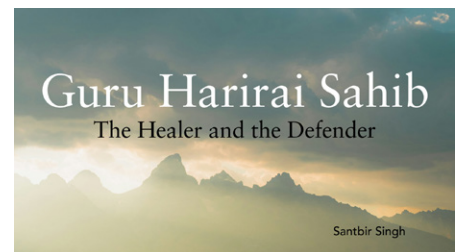
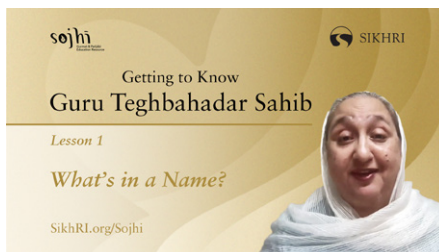
The Guru Granth Sahib Dictionary **NEW**

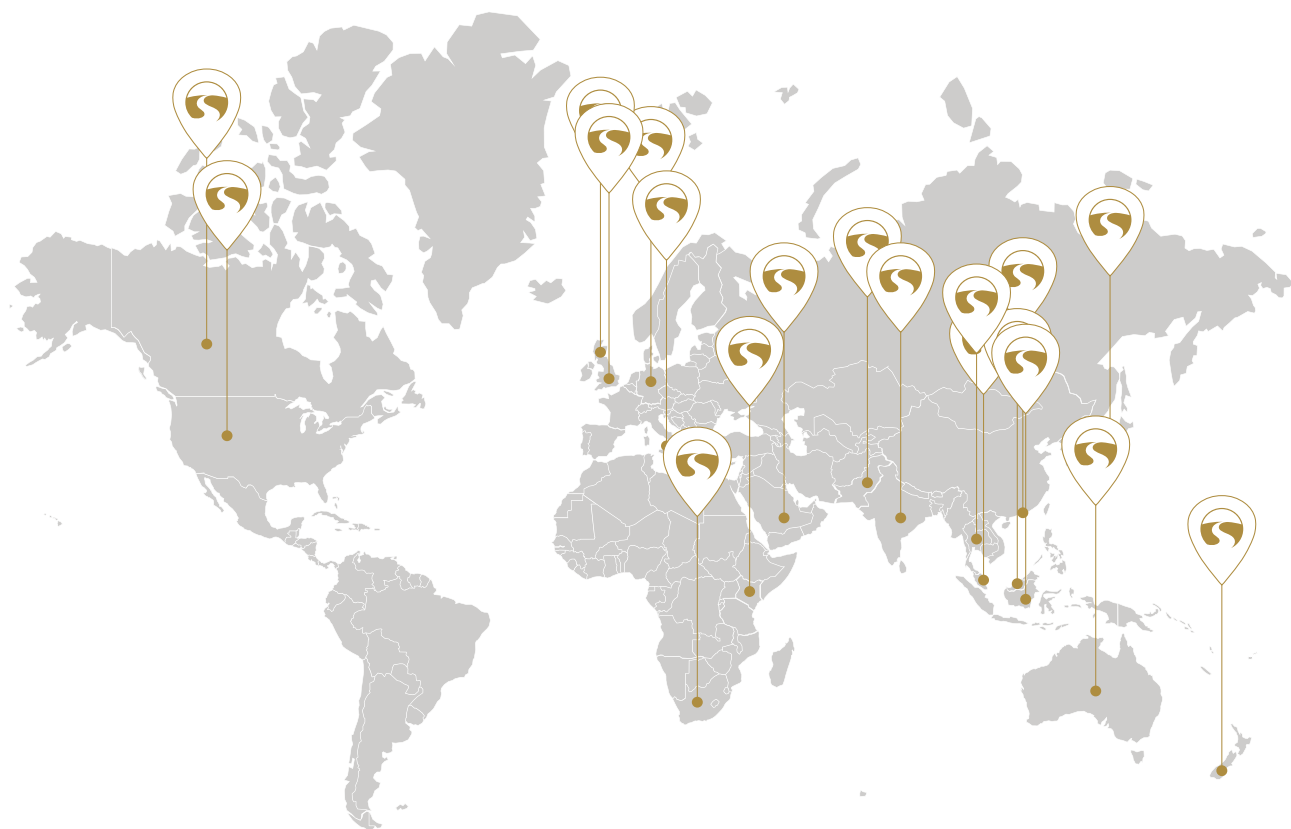
