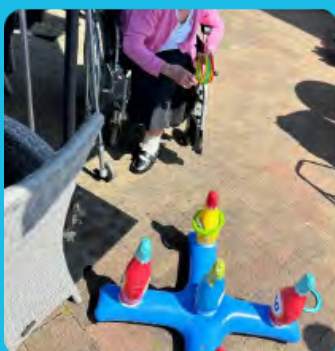
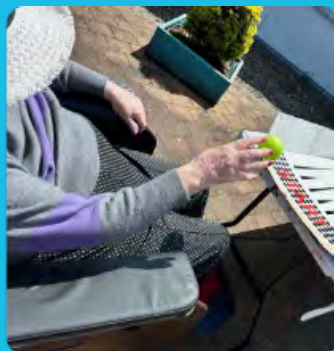


## Fun in the Sun

## A Special Visit

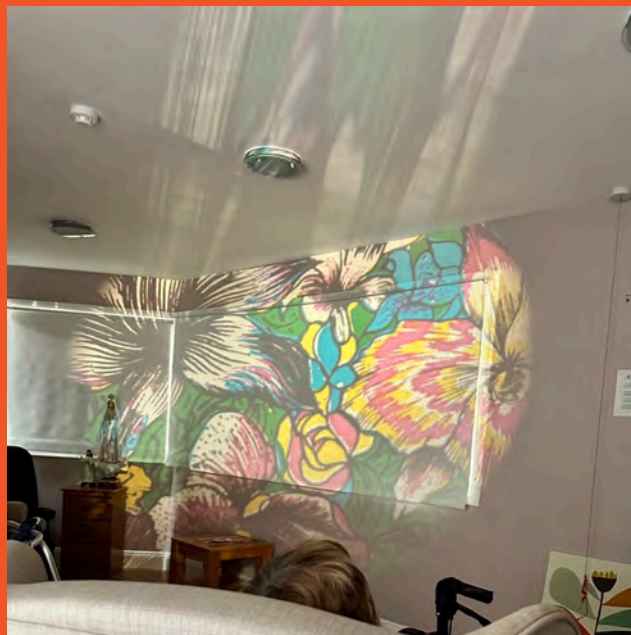

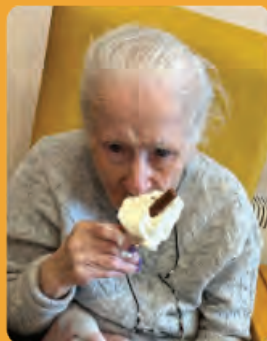


## Fresh Hair, **Fresh Smiles**
