We were delighted to join our wonderful resident Geraldine in celebrating her birthday here in Oakwood Lodge.

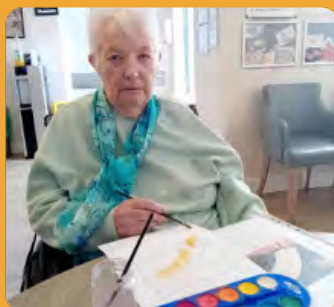
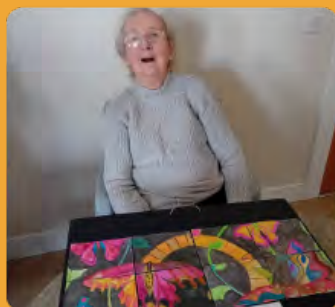


Fun Activities

Afternoon Tea



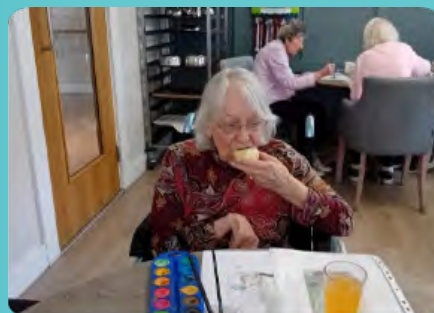

Mass at Oakwood Lodge



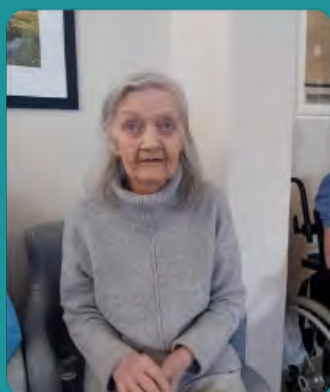
Our residents came together for a beautiful Mass and spiritual gathering. It was a meaningful time of prayer, reflection, and community, bringing comfort and peace to all who joined.
