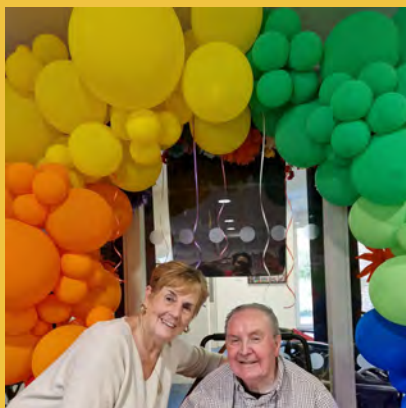
Ice cream Treats
