## Alzheimer's Tea Day



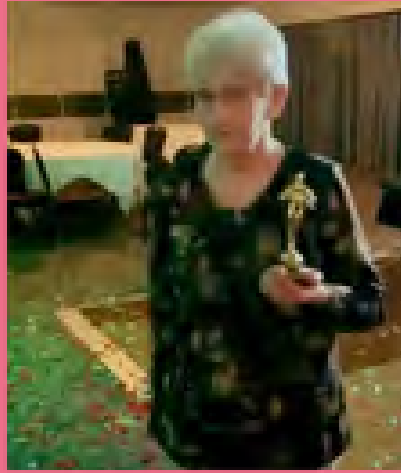

## Easter Arts



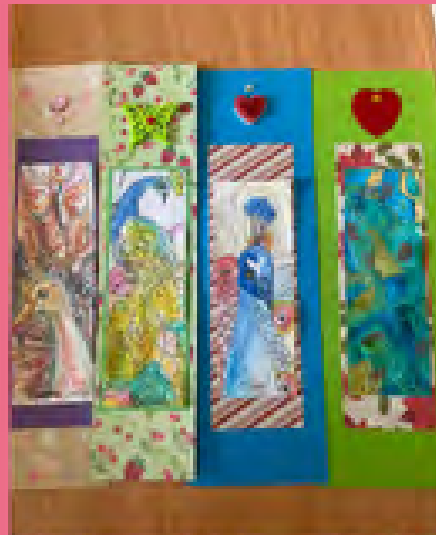
