57 Years of Golf History

Its amazing what effect the introduction of a new trophy has on players with some chasing these with unfettered zeal. In 2025, the Worst Individual Score of the year was snared by Peter Parker, with 102 nett, determined to set a standard that will be difficult to emulate. In a similar vein, Alex Jones took to the Choker Chain, turning a 13 shot gross score lead into a missed the podium in the Club Championships.

Although there have been rare nett scores of 60 or less, the verified Club record 58 nett at Hamersley was set by Theo Hazebroek in 2003 with the aid of a B grade handicap, and he later showed his versatility with a tee shot at the 14th into the tee sign and back into the ladies toilet.

Over the years very proficient Dummy Spitters included Jimmy Wells, Justin Avins, Warren Cluney and Tom Monger when things didn't go as planned. 'Paddy stop fidgeting in the bag' yelled Peter Aitchison after he duffed a putt. Paddy wasn't there the day his brand-new electric buggy blew up before it left the car park.

'Congratulations on playing 17 good holes Doug' crowed Pino Priolo after beating Doug Watson, the master of wit, in 1st hole of a Matchplay playoff. In 2014 Pino repeated the feat before losing the Matchplay Final for the second year in a row.

Fork Ups may have begun when Don Box wedged a ball in a tree fork on the 10th hole but none can match the year when a Vice President allowed free 'top shelf' drinks at the Annual Trophy night before needing to collect some following years fees to cover the bill. Over the years Paul Barnsley has built a reputation as a foodie. He boosted this at the 2014 Wind-Up, going to the wrong Wayne's house to find no-one there. Later he remarked 'I didn't mind anyone not being there but they could have left the food.'

Hammertime pondering the 2015 Matchplay Final produced this little gem; 'Makes you wonder which would be more enjoyable, watching Doug play or listening to Knappy play.'

'Take me out of the draw' declared Martin Fisher after finding out it was to be a late start on 1 July 2017. He played anyway scoring a hole-in-one on the 5th at Hamersley just before heavy rains caused the game to be abandoned.

Away games at Pinjarra in March 2017 and Secret Harbour in June 2018 were not kind to Dave Armstrong. For the second time Dave missed out on more than \$200 in Birdie Money because he signed for an incorrect score recorded by his playing partner.

'How good is golf?' Peter Bursey often asks. For Club Champion Doug Watson the 2018 Club Championships were outstanding, with scores of 75, 72, 71 and a record 69, clearly the club's best player ever. Only the handicap system stopped him from winning Nett Champion and the weekly prizes.

In 2023, the 55 year old Hamersley clubhouse was demolished with the new clubhouse and 2-tier driving range opening in December 2024. During the construction period many games had to be played away from Hamersley and after game meetings held at North Beach Bowling Club.

The 2024 Matchplay finals were also noticeable for the Simon Hartley quip "Doesn't say much for A graders to see two players in mobility carts contesting the Matchplay semi-final."

Northside Social Golf Club

Hamersley Public Golf Course was opened on 1 November 1968. At the same time the Northside Social Golf Club was formed with the original founding members including Stan Box, Bill, Les, Lionel and Tom, the latter four best known as the 'Four Wrinklies'. The inaugural President was Tom Monger and for the first few years a Vice President and Vice Captain were not required.

In 1975, Northside Social Golf Club was one of the fifteen original foundation members of the West Australian Golf League (WAGL), with some club members serving on WAGL committees over the years. John Spencer was Vice President in 1978, Brian Leaning was Secretary in 1981 and Jim Wells was Vice President from 2007 to 2009. There have been a number of delegates, but in the early years it was usually the newest club member, who knew little of either the Club or WAGL operations but this changed in 1991 when experienced members were nominated as delegates.

There is little information about the Sandgroper Tournament. However, it started as a combined event with Castle Golf Club originally played at Hamersley Public Golf Course before moving to Sun City Golf Course in 1977. Since 2009 the event has been organised solely and successfully by Northside and returned to Hamersley in 2014 as a Stableford event.

Booking games changed little over the years until 2020 when on-line booking was introduced. In the early days, a booker could only book for two groups from 7:00 am. This was not a problem early on but as membership of all clubs grew competition for booking increased. As many as five bookers per club would start arriving at 4:30 am to book an early Saturday or Sunday start. In the late eighties, Northside developed a roster system with each member given a designated booking group number from 1-5 and from each group five bookers were selected each week. Members generally booked about six to eight times per year. Since the advent of Saturday shopping, playing numbers decreased such that in the late nineties the City of Stirling relaxed the rule to permit a single booker from each club. This led a booker and back-up booker to book once or twice a year until 2017 when members decided on the system of paying a volunteer.

In the early days there were very few Perpetual Trophies. The Club Champion was the first trophy but the actual cup did not exist for several years. The original trophy was the Stirrers Pot in 1970, of unknown origin but still very appropriate to this day. The next trophy in 1975 was the President's trophy (donated by John Spencer and L Green) played over two consecutive Saturdays.

This was followed in 1976 by the Mercedes trophy (donated by the brothers Brian, Don and Stan Box), whereby the winner on the day was only eligible if he had not won a weekly game over the year.

The winner won a replica Mercedes Benz and each grade winner won a flagon of woobla (wine) with an indigenous image on the label. The tradition of wine still continues but now has changed to a bottle of wine for each grade winner.

In 1978 the Wooden Spoon and Most Improved were introduced, the Fork Up in 1988 for the biggest blunder of the year, then in 1991 the Best Putter in Club Championship (Brian Culling and Bernie O'Grady). The Pinjarra Cup (John Wright) and Steve Dreezens trophies were introduced in the eighties but have since been retired, the former due to irregular games being played at Pinjarra and the latter for not being for any particular game.

Several new trophies were introduced during the nineties, possibly due to an influx of new members. The Matchplay (Brendon Kenny) and Best at Away Venues (Vern Willis) were introduced in 1992 followed by Summer Cup (Brian Ginbey), Captains Trophy (John and Norm Noack), Winter Cup (Andrew Dudley), Most Consistent Trophy (Theo Hazebroek), Best Over 50's (Dave Aitchison) and Life Members Trophy (Norm Noack, Dave and Peter Aitchison) and Monthly Medal Trophy (John Burt). The first playing day of each year became a Memorial Trophy day following the passing of Don Box in 1999 and Alan Hunt on Christmas Day 1999. The Best Over 60's Trophy (Peter Hill) was retired after most of the older players left the Club and only one or two remaining members over 60 were eligible to win it. With so many members now in their 60's it was revived in 2014.

The last day of the year is traditionally Ambrose Fours, with such features of club shirts banned for the day, teeing from 18" high hosepipe on 1st and refusal of offered beverages was not permitted, which often prevented some players from completing the game. The last rule was later removed due to drinking and driving laws but Dennis Allison plied everyone before the game for several years but this has also ceased.

There have been many highlights over the years but also a few lowlights. The lowlights include a member playing in the Dianella Spring Cup changing his card after the game, thinking he would win. Ironically he was already Runner Up and even after changing his card he remained Runner Up on a countback until caught.

Highlights include playing Pennants from 1999 to 2009 being runner up in Division II in 2000 and Division V in 2009, winner Division II and Division III in 2004 and but the greatest victory was against Castle Golf Club. Each year there were one or two games against Castle with individual Stableford matches which Northside habitually lost.

On this particular day the score of individual matches was tied with only one game, John Bowman and his Castle opponent still out on the course. Legend has it that John lost the match but his opponent had 15 clubs in his bag. The resultant penalty was enough to win the day.

During the period 2013 to 2015, the increase of FIFO work and medical ailments (heart bypass, pacemakers, joint replacements etc.), contributed to some low attendances at games and at times the after game meetings looked more like an outpatient clinic.

Magic Moments, Characters and Quotes

The hottest playing day was also the hottest day recorded on 23 February 1991 when the temperature hit 46.2° C. Rarely have we been rained off the course but a sudden summer downpour on 6 February 1993 was enough to call off the game.

Some members had obvious nicknames ranging from follicle challenged Peter 'High Beam' and Dave 'Low Beam' Aitchison and John 'Moon' Wright, odour emitting Peter 'Windy' Hill, diminutive Brian 'Egg on Legs' Ginbey, Brian 'Hypo' Culling always carried a mobile pharmacy in his bag, Michael 'The Kraut' Klein to the less obvious Dennis 'Cowboy' Reid and Lucas 'A to Z' Karakyriakos. Steve Grace later emulated 'Hypo' keeping all sorts of dodgy pills in his bag, and anyone who accepted one had strange reactions.

Brian Ginbey at about 5ft 5in and not a big hitter, but at Burswood his 150 m drive left a lasting impression on Ray Stoltze's forehead and he still had the dimples to prove it when he passed away in 2021.

'Wayne would have been a good golfer if I had started him at 12 instead of 13' said Norm Smith of son Wayne Smith who had a successful career in Asia.

Carsten Bonde holed out from 150 m in Matchplay to be told by Ken Leaning, 'You have to replay your shot for playing out of turn'. Ken was notorious for ball-creep during marking, jangling keys, coughing or whatever to annoy opponents to protect his 20 cent side bets.

In 1998, after 2 months with 143 best score, Toby G riled at being told to take lessons and promptly resigned without actually having become a member.

'That's the end of my championships' boomed Norm Noack, forever the optimist, after miscuing his drive on the 1st tee on the 1st day in 2001, before going on to become Club Champion with a round that included 17 pars and a 9 on the 14th.

'I got a 16 from here a few weeks ago' quipped Bob Brennan, after being 2 near the 2nd large fairway tree on the 11th hole, before proceeding to shoot the same score.

Michael P unfazed by Dianella Spring Cup fiasco scored a non-hole in one. Teeing off on a par 3 didn't see the ball land and after a search he 'amazingly' found the ball just off the green before a player tending the flag found a ball in the hole.

The Bowman boys renowned for duck hooks and slices 'Oh-oh they're big guys, don't tell them' cried Bill Bowman after being falsely told his tee shot into the car park from the 10th had hit Norm Noack's and John Wright's cars.

John Bowman put two balls on someone's front lawn opposite the 11th green but only asked for one back when told 'I'm getting sick of you guys landing balls in my yard, if only I had a dollar for every ball'.

In 2016 the Best Social Player award was renamed the Paul Barnsley Social player award, after his passing in July, in recognition of the way Paul managed himself not only among his peers on the golf course but in facing motor neurone disease. In 2018 the club celebrated its 50th year. With the sad passing of club stalwart Peter Aitchison in August and Dave winning the Kellerberrin Cup after 35 years of trying, it was the right time to recognise the efforts of Peter and Paddy, Dave and Jan for being on the committee a remarkable 27 times in 31 years but also opening their home for functions over these many years. Consequently the Best Away Games trophy was renamed the Aitchison Cup.

The year 2020 will be remembered for Covid 19 with frequent changes directed by authorities prompted changes to managing overall club and weekly practices. Initially games were cancelled and upon our return, on-line payment replaced weekly cash payment for games and side competitions and the Game Planner in conjunction with on-line advance booking. The year was also notable for induction of our inaugural Honorary Members for services to the club in a non-playing role, Jan and Paddy Aitchison, as well as being the club's first female members. The paperless era commenced with the development of a club website and a move to MiScore for booking and scoring games.

An historic 'Grand Slam' feat most believed impossible in a single calendar year occurred in 2021 when Ron Cunningham won the Aitchison Cup (Best Away Games), Best Over 60s, Most Improved, Most Consistent made more remarkable by winning by the Wooden Spoon.

Despite all the restrictions with Covid-19, golf has increased in popularity and during 2022 our first female playing members joined the club.

As always, members look for a new edge or perhaps wedge. 2025 was no exception, with 3 major introductions. The Worst individual Score trophy (Alex Jones & Clint Aitchison), Choker Chain (Doug Watson) and on the fundraising side Chase the Ace with Tony Hamer-Mathew being inaugural winner.

Tom Monger kept meticulous records of everything associated with the Club, right down to every ball won. Unfortunately after getting after getting par instead of birdie and burying his putter in the 12th green, then subsequently being suspended for a couple of weeks, his temper got the better of him he resigned and destroyed the records. Fortunately, due to the Perpetual Trophies, most of the important records are contained in this chronicle.

If your name is not on a trophy, there is always next year.....
