# GENERAL CONDITIONS

## 1. SUBJECT

F.T Academy runs a tennis & school program adapted to players from age 10 to 18, searching to combine intensive tennis & school program, either in a French based or American based high school system. The Academy program includes 30 hours of tennis and physical training, medical care and supervision, as well as the coaching in regional tournaments, full-board accommodation all year round.

After becoming acquainted with the content of the Tennis Program, having visited the sports facilities and the site of the Academy and having taken note of the catering and accommodation arrangements, the parent(s) or guardians have decided, in conjunction with the student/sports player, to place their children into the F.T Academy for a period determined by the program selected, on the basis of the specific terms and the prices mentioned in the Academy's registration documents. The Academy's registration documents and these General Terms and Conditions, including the internal rules, together comprise the contract (hereinafter the "Contract").

## 2. INTERNAL RULES / DISCIPLINE / BEHAVIOUR

The student and his parents or guardians shall receive the internal rules before or upon arrival at the site and declare that they have been duly informed and have obtained all the explanations that they may have required, prior to the signature of the Contract, about the imperative rules of health, safety, behavior and conduct attached to group living outside the student's usual household, which the Academy requires that students comply with. The student hereby undertakes to comply with these rules without restriction or reservation and to observe the internal rules throughout the school year. In particular:

- Students are not allowed to receive private outside guests on the premises of the Academy (unless expressly authorised to do so by the person in charge of the Academy).
- Students must have suitable clothing, bathing suit (bathing trunks), towels and linen insufficient quantities. Bed linen is provided by the Academy. A laundry service is available to the students.
- The use of unlawful substances (including alcohol) is absolutely prohibited within the Academy. Unless the Academy decides otherwise in writing beforehand, each student undertakes to wear the Academy's t-t-shirt, or match shirt during official competitions.
- Students understand that they represent the Academy at all times, whether on site or away, and therefore undertake to represent the Academy and its values.

## 3. PRICES / TERMS OF PAYMENT

The price shown on the enrolment form is fixed and individual, and includes sports services (tennis practice, physical preparation, mental training, assessment, tournament follow-up), tuition and full board. It does not include transport to and from school during school holidays or at weekends for those who so wish. At the time of enrolment, an initial deposit of €5,000 of the total amount must be paid. This amount is intended to cover the administrative costs of enrolment and the fixed costs of implementing the year's program. The balance of the fees must be paid by bank transfer, cash or credit card: either in full by a single payment before the start of the program or in half-yearly instalments on 15 September, following the start of the school, and on 15 January, following the start of the second term

#### 4. CANCELLATION POLICE

In the event of cancellation of the Student's enrolment by his/her parent or legal representative, whether before or after the start of the Program, all sums due for the full academic year shall remain payable in full.

No refund, partial or total, shall be granted under any circumstances, including but not limited to withdrawal for personal, academic, disciplinary, or medical reasons.

Any exception to this principle may only be granted at the sole discretion of the Academy's Management, which reserves the exclusive right to decide whether to authorize a refund and, if so, to determine the amount thereof. Such decision shall be final and not subject to appeal.

In all cases, any administrative fees remain fully due and non-refundable.

Any request for cancellation must be submitted to the Academy by registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt or delivered by hand. If the request is based on medical grounds, supporting documents must be provided in a sealed envelope for the attention of the Academy Director.

By signing the present agreement, the parent or legal representative expressly acknowledges and accepts that all fees are due in full and that no refund shall be made, except in the exceptional case of a written decision issued by the Academy's Management.

##### • Cancellation by the Academy

In the event of cancellation of enrolment by the Academy, for a serious and legitimate reason duly attested, the Academy may reclaim the year's fees due.

In the event of cancellation of enrolment by the Academy, for a serious and legitimate reason duly proven, the latter may claim the year due.

#### 5. THE TEAM

The teaching team is made up of:

- The Director of the Academy who leads the entire educational team including support staff and activity leaders, and is responsible for all program as well as the safety and security of the students.
- The Director of the French section who is in charge of the entire educational team and support staff and activity leaders in this section.
- The Director of the international section who is in charge of the entire educational team and support staff and activity leaders in this section.
- A head coach who is in charge of all the professional tennis trainers and physical and mental fitness trainers
- A boarding manager who is responsible for and supervises the night guards/activity leaders who are in charge of the boarding students. Their role is to ensure the safety and security of the students and to run extra-curricular activities and ensure compliance with the rules of community living.
- Physiotherapists and osteopaths who treat and monitor players according to the needs identified by the coaches

## **6• BOARDING (optional)**

Academics are accommodated in double, triple or quadruple rooms. The rooms are cleaned twice a week by a cleaning team. Academics undertake not to damage the rooms made available to them, to clean them at least once a week and to make their beds every morning. No change of accommodation, including a refund, will be considered during the year. Students are asked not to leave valuables unattended, as the Academy cannot be held responsible for any loss or theft. Supervisors are responsible for the supervision and safety of students. Mobile phones must be handed in to the supervisors on duty when the lights go out at 10pm. Academics may collect their mobile phones after breakfast.

## **7. CATERING**

Meals are taken in the International Tennis Centre cafeteria. All boarding students are required to take their meals there. The boarding package comprises 3 meals including breakfast, lunch and dinner with options for starter, main course and dessert. Only carbohydrates are included in the sports programme.

## **8. SPORT TRAININGS**

Each academician will benefit from personalised training tailored to his or her level. Before joining the programme, candidates will undergo a test to assess their level of play so that they can join a training group appropriate to their level. Tournament monitoring in the Hérault region is provided throughout the school year by the team of coaches.

## **9. SCHOOLING**

The students in the French section shall be taught according to rules of the academy online private school system. External professional teaching staffs are available on site to offer the students continued and sustained educational assistance. Students in the international section will follow the American curriculum. The program covers the entire school year. The hours spent on school work shall be spread out from Monday to Friday and shall be made to fit in with the tennis coaching in the mornings.

## **10. ACTIVITIES – OUTINGS – TRANSPORTATION**

All non-academic and non-sporting activities, with the exception of the swimming pool (examples of activities on offer: board games, mountain biking, arts and crafts, etc.), are supervised by activity leaders/supervisors. Under-age boarding students must not leave the academy during the week. Except with the prior written agreement of their parents or legal guardians, boarding students may only leave the academy at week ends from Friday evening/Saturday morning if their parents, legal guardians or any other person duly authorised by them collect them from the site. In any event, students must be back on Sunday by 6 p.m. at the latest. Students and their parents or legal guardians are solely responsible for transporting academics home. The Academy has the right not to authorise the departure of young people in agreement with their parents or legal guardians for compulsory activities.

## 11. PUNISHMENT- EXCLUSION

Students and their parents or legal guardians undertake to comply scrupulously with the Contract, including the internal rules, failing which they may be sanctioned with exclusion, after a meeting of the Academy's Disciplinary Board. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Academy reserves the right to temporarily or permanently exclude, subject to reasonable notice in the light of the facts, any student whose attitude, behaviour or dress is known to be contrary to good morals or likely to endanger the safety of persons or property. In such cases, parents or legal representatives will be kept informed of any breaches or problems observed and, in the event of permanent exclusion, will be invited to come and collect the academician for whom they are responsible. Academicians, parents and legal representatives will have the right to present their explanations, which the Academy undertakes to hear in good faith, before any final decision is taken. As a penalty clause, in the event of damage caused by the pupil's sanctioned behaviour, the pupil will be liable for a lump sum of €2,000. This sum may be added to the annual amount payable by the pupil in the event of exclusion. In accordance with article 1152 of the French Civil Code : "Where the agreement provides that the party failing to perform will pay a certain sum by way of damages, the other party may not be awarded a greater or lesser sum. Nevertheless, the court may, even of its own motion, moderate or increase the agreed penalty if it is manifestly excessive or derisory. Any stipulation to the contrary shall be deemed unwritten.

## 12. ATTESTATION/MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

It is up to the parents or guardians to inform the Academy about the physical state of the student if this is likely to have consequences on his sporting activities. The parents or guardians hereby duly authorize the Academy to accomplish whatever acts are necessary in case of hospitalization or surgical operation. The parents or guardians hereby declare that the physical constitution and the state of health of the student who is in their charge enable him to practice sport in general, and tennis in particular, intensively. The student's parents or guardians have been asked to fill in a health questionnaire which is enclosed with the Registration documents and shall bear the consequences of any incorrect or inaccurate answers, without any remedy against the Academy. Upon arrival at the Academy's site, the student shall bring a medical certificate certifying his aptitude to practice sport as well as a document enabling the Academy to check that he is up-to-date with his immunizations.

### **13. CIVIL LIABILITY / INSURANCE**

The Academy is insured in accordance with article L. 321-1 of the French Sports Code. This insurance policy is designed to cover the Academy against the financial consequences of its civil liability for physical injury, tangible and intangible damage caused to third parties owing to the operation of a sports establishment. The liability of the Academy may only be invoked in case of an accident resulting from a clear failure to comply with safety guidelines or inappropriate use of any devices or other facilities. The Academy cannot under any circumstance be held responsible in case of theft. Moreover, it is strongly advised that the students do not bring valuable items with them on to the site. The student and his parents or guardians must take out a personal civil liability insurance policy, covering the student for all the damage that he might cause to third parties, by his own actions, throughout the Program. Moreover, in accordance with article L. 321-4 of the French Sports Code, the Academy hereby recommends that students take out a personal insurance policy covering any physical injury that their sports activities may give rise to, with the insurance company of their choosing.

### **14. MAJOR FORCE**

None of the parties shall have to perform their obligations under the Contract in the event of circumstances of force majeure, as defined by article 1218 of the French Civil Code. Should this be the case, the parties shall meet in order to find a satisfactory alternative solution and remedy the situation.

### **15. DATA PROTECTION**

In accordance with French Data Protection Law dated 6 January 1978, the data processing of the student's application shall give the student, his parents or guardians the right to access, rectify and challenge any use or processing of his personal data in keeping with the terms of that law. In order to exercise this right, the student or his parents or guardians should contact the relevant department of the Academy.

### **16. IMAGE RIGHTS**

The student or, if he/she is a minor, his/her legal representative(s) authorise(s) the academy to use his/her image, as part of the promotion of the academy's activities and those of its academicians and/or players, on French territory and for a period of ten (10) years, on the following media:

- Paper, in particular by means of posters or the press and similar publications (in particular dailies, weeklies, monthlies, magazines, reviews, catalogues);
- Internet and all electronic communication networks;
- Hertzian or digital broadcasting. Advertising material, including brochures, signs, displays and any other form of POP or direct marketing.



**17. APPLICABLE LAW / SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

This Contract shall be governed by French law. Should any disputes arise in connection with the performance of the Contract or its consequences, they shall be brought before the court with jurisdiction over the defendant.

**18. ACCEPTANCE**

I have read, understood and accept these General Terms and Conditions of the F.T Academy, including the internal rules that were provided to me prior to the signature of this document, and I understand that any breach of these General Terms and Conditions and of the internal rules may lead to the expulsion of the student.

**19. APPLICABLE VERSION**

The French version of these General Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
