Today, I take great pride in seeing how far our students have come-many surpassing even our highest expectations.

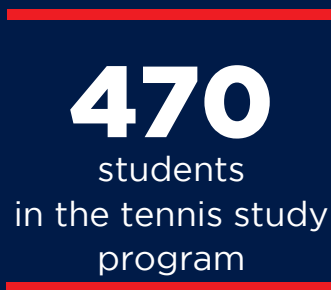
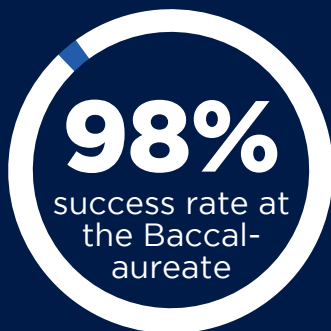

## SPORT PROGRAM

**Our program is designed to provide intensive Tennis training and high-level competition while maintaining academic excellence.**

The academy sets high expectations, and the pace is demanding to ensure each player reaches their full potential.

### **THE SPORT PROGRAM IS BUILT ON 4 KEY PILLARS :**

- **Mastery Through Repetition** - Reinforcing essential technical fundamentals through consistent practice.
- **Intensive Physical Training** - Developing strength, endurance, agility and injury prevention
- **Mental Coaching & Player Development** - Strengthening resilience, focus and competitive mindset
- **High-Level competition** - A structured tournament schedule featuring official events to maximize match experience



## MEDICAL FOLLOW-UP

At the academy, we prioritize the health and well-being of our athletes by providing comprehensive medical and physiotherapy support. Our team of specialists includes physical therapists, physicians, podiatrists, and other healthcare professionals.

Upon admission, each player undergoes a thorough medical assessment, giving our sports team valuable insights for personalized care. Throughout the year, ongoing medical support ensures players stay in peak condition. In the event of an injury, students have regular access to physiotherapy services to aid recovery and prevent future issues.

# THE SPORTS SEASON IS ORGANIZED

## 1 SEPTEMBER

- Conduct comprehensive Video analysis of each player
- Complete tennis and physical assessment leading to the implementation of a precise annual training plan, highlighting the main AREAS TO BE WORKED ON
- Follow up in competition (1 to 2 tournaments) to provide an initial analysis of the tactical work to be done.

## 2 OCTOBER - DECEMBER

- Focus on technical improvement and, if needed, make necessary adjustments to a player's foundation
- Prioritize physical training in the areas of endurance, power, mobility, and explosivity
- Gradual integration into match situations (between 3 and 4 tournaments)
- Develop a unique playing identity
- Implement mental training through individual and group sessions to enhance performance.



## PHYSICAL TRAINING

Physical conditioning is an essential part of our academy's program, playing a key role in each player's development and rapid progress. Every student participates in daily training sessions lasting 1.5 hours, with workouts carefully tailored to match the demands of the season. This structured approach ensures optimal physical preparation, enhancing performance and reducing injury risk.

### 1<sup>ST</sup> PHASE SEPTEMBER-DECEMBER

Put emphasis on enhancing fundamental abilities, such as endurance and muscle strength, by working on basic conditioning exercises

# INTO 5 DISTINCT PERIODS.

## 3 JANUARY - MARCH

- Emphasize tactical development in the context of match play (increasing competition intensity)
- Concentrate on solidifying the player's distinctive playing style
- Provide physical training geared towards preparing for competition
- Participate in 4 to 6 tournaments to further refine skills and build experience.

## 4 APRIL - JUNE

- Prepare for intense competition with daily in-situation match play and practice sessions.
- Competing in 6 to 10 tournaments to hone their skills and refine their strategies.
- High-Intensity Physical Training Schedule

## 5 SUMMER

- Practical implementation of work done during the year through an intensive competition program (3 weeks of SUMMER TOUR or competition week)



### 2<sup>ND</sup> PHASE JANUARY- APRIL

Prepare for the competitive season by focusing on physical training that emphasizes speed and coordination improvement.

### 3<sup>RD</sup> PHASE MAY-AUGUST

Design physical training specifically for the competition cycle, including activities that focus on recovery and improving core flexibility.

# TOURNAMENTS



## TOURNAMENTS: SCHEDULE & PROGRAMMING

Competitions provide students with valuable opportunities to evaluate their performance and identify areas for improvement in technical, tactical and mental aspects of their game. They also serve as essential benchmarks for coaches to monitor each player's progress throughout the year.

Located in The Hérault department, the academy benefits from a rich tournament calendar, hosting 20 in-house tournaments and having access to over 40 additional events in the region, including numerous international youth competitions. Students typically compete in 20 official tournaments on average between september and June , with the option to enter up to 10 more during the summer.

For high-performing players (minimum Top 20 national ranking), we offer a specialized national/international pathway for the U14 & U18 categories.

As strong advocates of the UTR system, all our students are registered and regularly participate in point-earning matches both within and outside the academy, ensuring continuous competitive development.

# SCHOOLING

## Fully Accredited U.S. High School Program

We offer a fully accredited U.S. high school program for grades 6 to 12, featuring NCAA-approved courses aligned with the rigorous standards of American high schools. Our curriculum integrates digital and blended learning methods, powered by our proprietary Learning Management System (LMS). Upon graduation, students earn a fully accredited U.S. high school diploma. Our program is provided in partnership with American High School, a private institution accredited by SACS CASI (Advanced/Cognia) and recognized by the NCAA

## Seamless Integration of Academics & Sports

Our academy ensures a close connection between academics and sports by structuring the schedule to accommodate both. Students engage in 8 hours of classes per week, with small class sizes (6 to 10 students) fostering an interactive and supportive learning environment. Additionally, there is a mandatory one-hour supervised study session each evening to reinforce academic progress.

## Pathway to College Scholarships

By completing our U.S. high school program with NCAA-approved courses, students become eligible for scholarships and grants for their college or university education. Beyond academics, our program cultivates essential life skills that prepare students for success in higher education and beyond, including:

- Increased motivation and engagement
- Strong independent learning skills
- Effective time management and prioritization
- Digital and multimedia literacy
- Advanced research and information evaluation skills
- Positive and productive teacher-student communication



## APPLIED ENGLISH



English language proficiency is a key component of our curriculum, with a strong emphasis on all forms of oral and written communication. Our intensive English program ensures that students are well-prepared for American university entrance exams and fully equipped with the language skills needed for higher education. Starting in grade 10, students take specialized courses designed to prepare them for the TOEFL and SAT exams. By grade 11, all students are automatically registered for these exams and receive structured preparation to maximize their performance. This comprehensive approach guarantees that our graduates are confident, proficient, and ready to excel in an English-speaking academic environment.

## **ORIENTATION DAYS**

Twice a year, the academy hosts a mandatory 3-day event at the start of each semester. These events are designed to strengthen social bonds among students through team challenges that test both physical and mental endurance. Activities include camping in rough conditions, fostering resilience, teamwork, and a strong sense of community within the academy.

## **REVIEW & FOLLOW-UP**

Student progress is continuously monitored and evaluated based on their athletic and academic objectives set at the beginning of each term. At the end of every term, students receive a detailed progress report, which serves as a key discussion point during parent-teacher-coach mee-

tings, ensuring alignment between their sports and academic journeys.

To sharpen students' competitive spirit, the academy organizes supervised boxing, judo, and wrestling sessions, providing an additional platform for developing discipline, focus, and resilience.

# SCHOLARSHIPS

In the U.S., student-athletes can earn scholarships to compete for university sports teams. The number of scholarships varies by sport and division.

For NCAA Division 1 tennis, Men's teams offer up to 5 scholarships. Women's teams offer up to 8 scholarships.

The scholarship amount depends on the player's level and the university's team ranking. The table below outlines the general correlation between a player's level and the scholarship amount typically awarded.

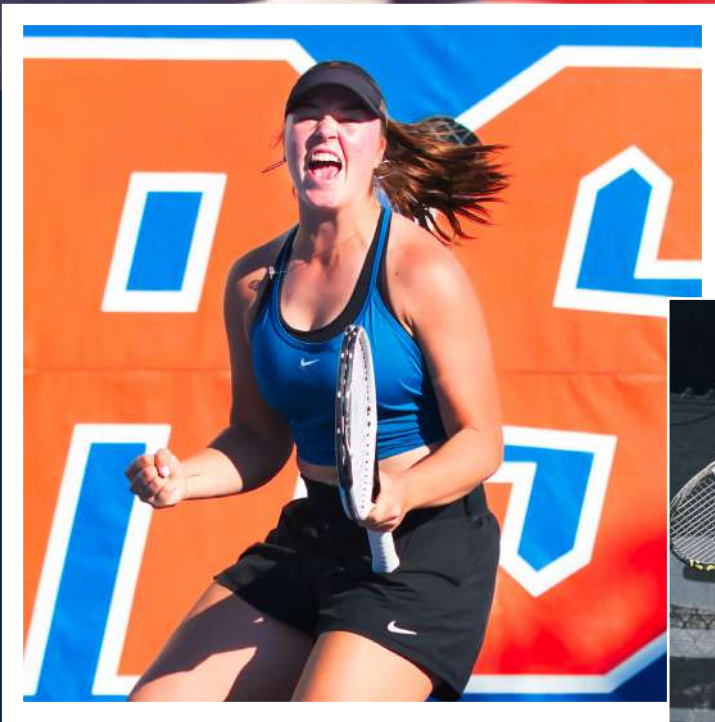

# TRAINING CENTER

## The intensive training centre is open all year round.

This tennis training program is designed for high-level players with the goal of reaching the national or international level of competition (ETA, ITF, ATP, or WTA). 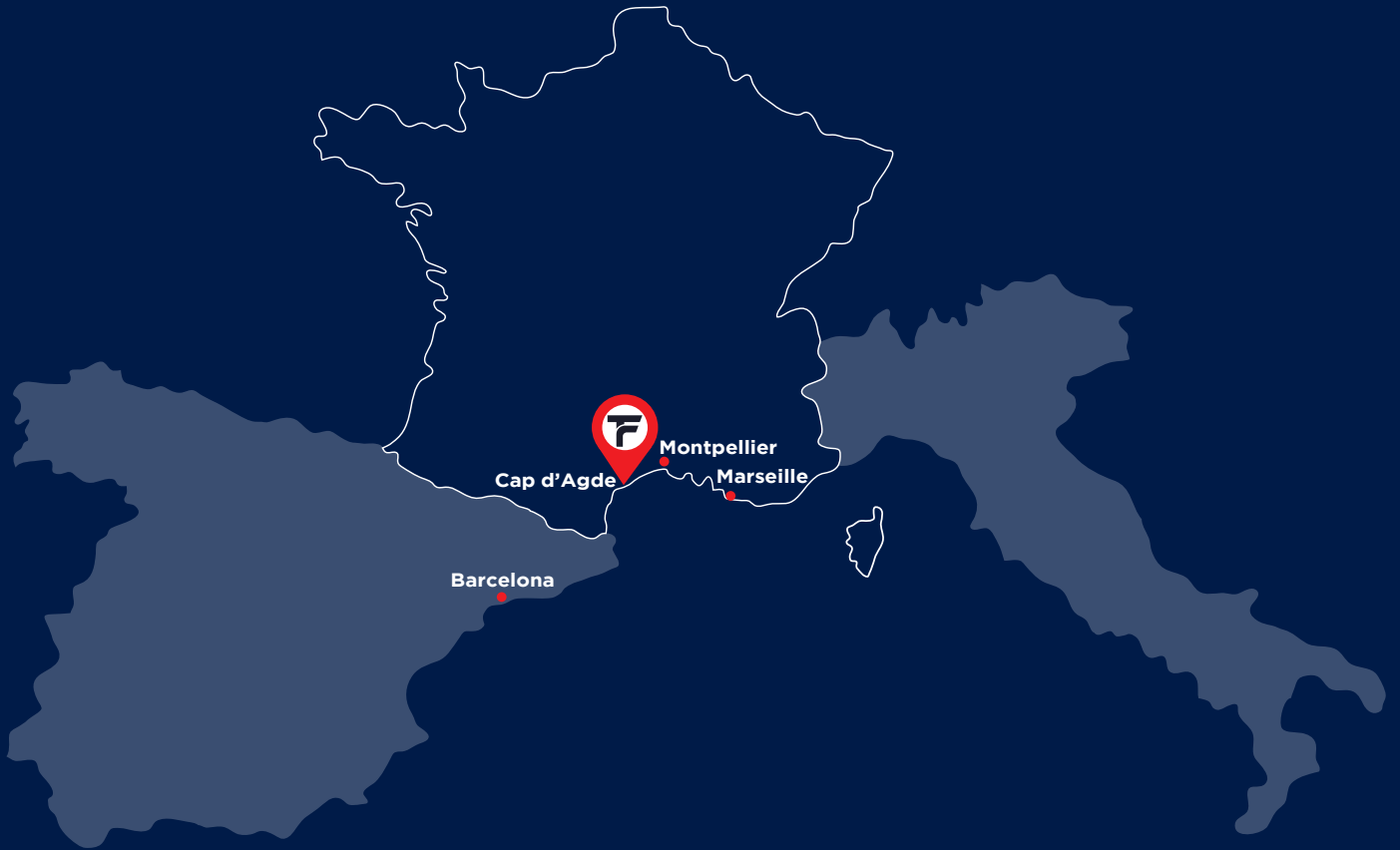
