FOOTWEAR

In winter, Terms 2 and 3, students will wear the approved plain black leather, lace-up school-style **SHOES**.

For health and safety reasons shoes are required to be sturdy, support the foot and have a heel of approximately 1.5 - 2 cm.

Footwear must be clean and have no embellishments or logos of any kind **NB**: Leather and canvas Converse, boots, ballet flats, skate shoes and sports shoes are **NOT PERMITTED.**

Do not purchase any sports branded black leather or canvas shoes. Should families choose to buy incorrect footwear, they will be in breach of the Uniform Regulations.

In summer, Terms 1 and 4, students will wear the shoes as defined in the winter uniform, or SANDALS. The sandals can be black ROMAN SANDALS or black BIRKENSTOCK LEATHER SANDALS with or without the backstrap only.

Students who wear black Birkenstocks with a backstrap need to have it fastened at all times. Jandal-style footwear with a thong between the toes is **NOT PERMITTED**.

In all Science and Technology rooms, students will wear the approved plain black leather, lace-up school-style **SHOES** or their **TRAINERS** that are used for **PE**.

UNIFORM REGULATIONS

- Belmont Intermediate School uniform must be worn to and from school and for all school functions.
- Items that are not part of the school uniform may not be worn, undergarments must not be visible.
- Approved footwear and socks only to be worn, long socks must be worn pulled up.
- The sports uniform is to be worn for all physical education lessons and sports events.
- Uniforms must be neat and tidy at all times. All items should be clearly named.
- A high-visibility vest must be worn when riding a bicycle/ scooter to and from school.
- For safety reasons, only the following jewellery may be worn:
 - a wristwatch
 - single set of gold or silver plain studs for pierced ears no markings, stones or engraving
- The school cap or bucket hat is optional for all outdoor activities in terms 1 and 4.
- Lipstick and eye makeup are not permitted.
- Nail polish is permitted as long as it is a transparent (clear). Nails must be kept short and neat. Acrylic/ false nails are not permitted.
- Hair must be well groomed and tidy. Hair ties and hair adornments are only permitted in navy blue or black.
- Only hair colours in the natural human hair range are acceptable. Purple, orange, lime green, pink etc. are not permitted.
- Un-natural coloured hair extensions or any hair extensions/ beading/ extension braids of any kind are not permitted.
- In the interest of safety or hygiene, any teacher has the right to request hair is tied back, or jewellery removed.
