UPCOMING ADULT PROGRAMS

Co-ed Adult Kickball

Registration continues through August 22, with the season tentatively beginning September 2. Cost is \$185 per team. Registeration taken in office only.

Adult Volleyball & Basketball

Registration taken September 22 through October 24. Leagues for men & women, with a 12-game season beginning in early November. Cost is \$295 per team for volleyball, and \$475 per team (plus \$3.50/player) for basketball. Registeration taken in office only.
