Do you have lived experience as a parent in recovery from opiates or another substance use disorder?

If so, and you'd like a career helping others navigate child and family systems, we have an opportunity for you – one that gets you:

- Free college tuition up to 21 credits
- Books and materials (including a new computer).
- Family/Adult Peer Support Credentialing

We're specifically looking for parents who have experience with any of the following entities:

- Department of Child Safety or Child Protective Services
- Addiction and Recovery
- Behavioral Health
- Juvenile Justice

As a participant in Resilient Roots Apprenticeship Program (RRAP) formerly known as the Parent Peer Support Social Work Scholarship Stipend Program, you have the opportunity to attend classes through Mesa Community College Social Work Program and participate in service learning. After the first 6 months, you are then eligible for a paid position in an apprenticeship program allowing you to gain on-the-job experience as well as receive an additional 15 college credits at MCC.

To apply you will need a high school diploma or GED, along with proof of Arizona residency for at least one year. New cohorts begin every 6 months, with applications being accepted on a rolling basis through April 2028.
