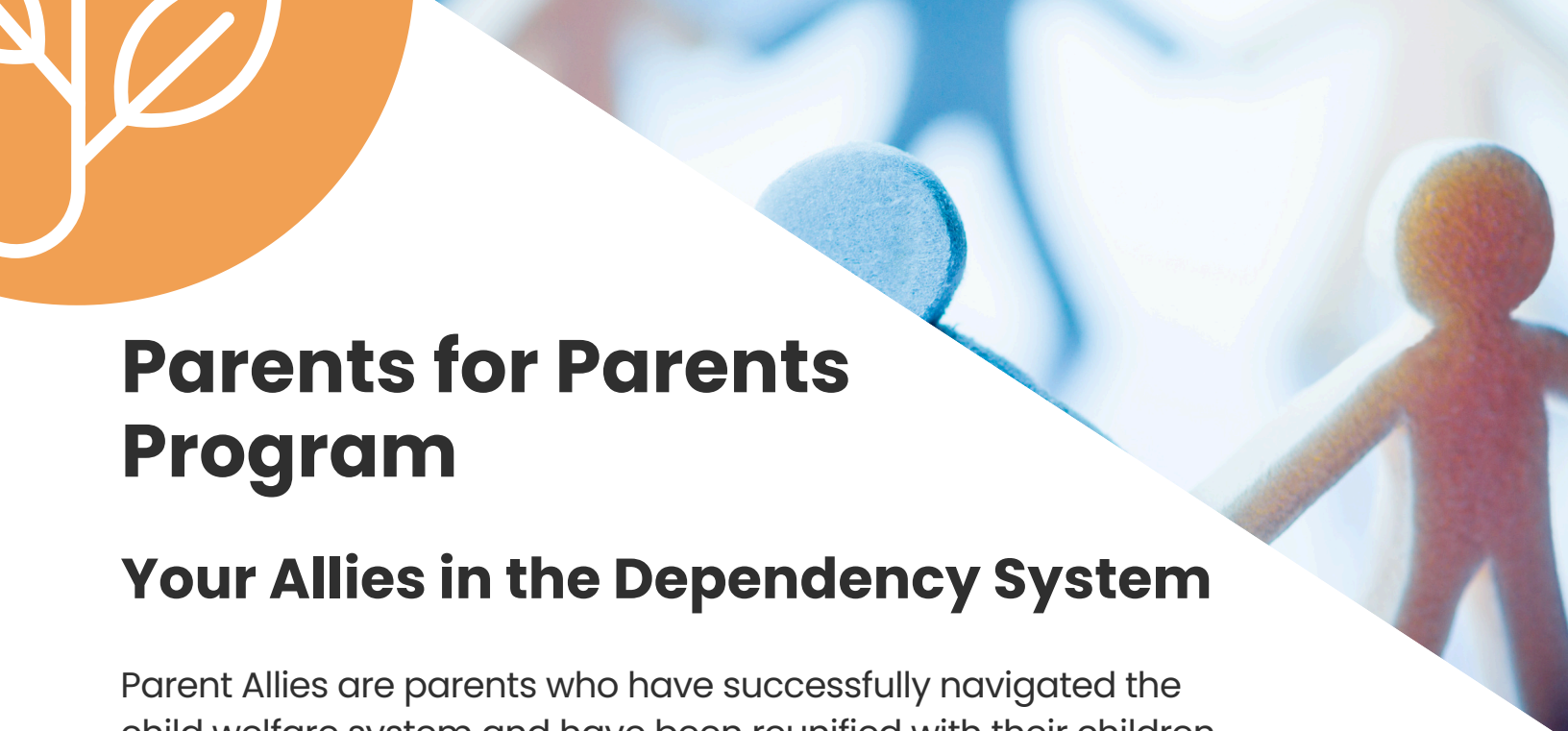




Parents for Parents Program
