DIRECTIONS AND CIRCUIT ENTRY

- Following the postcode (see bottom of page) you will arrive at the circuit

- Knockhill Racing Circuit is located on the A823, **IF TRAVELLING FROM THE EAST OR SOUTH**, head to Junction 4, M90 Kelty. **IF TRAVELLING FROM THE WEST**, please head over the new Clackmannan Bridge and head on the A977 and turn right at Powmill. **IF TRAVELLING FROM THE NORTH**, motorway signs will say exit Junction 6, you can also head to Junction 4 as an alternative route.

- Upon arriving at the **Main Entrance**, circuit stewards will direct you to the designated public parking areas (options marked on the map).

- Prior to arrival, you will have received an E-Ticket in advance. On your arrival at the **MAIN ENTRANCE TICKET GATE**, please display your e-ticket to gain access to the circuit.

- Once you arrive at the Main Entrance Ticket Gate, make yourself known to Sophie Cottrell (on the number below), who will be waiting to greet you and provide your passes for entry into the race paddock.

- From there, make your way into the paddock, where you will need to walk into the inner area of the circuit via a public footbridge close to the pitlane exit.

- Once in the inner circuit area, our VIP Hospitality Unit will be easy to spot.

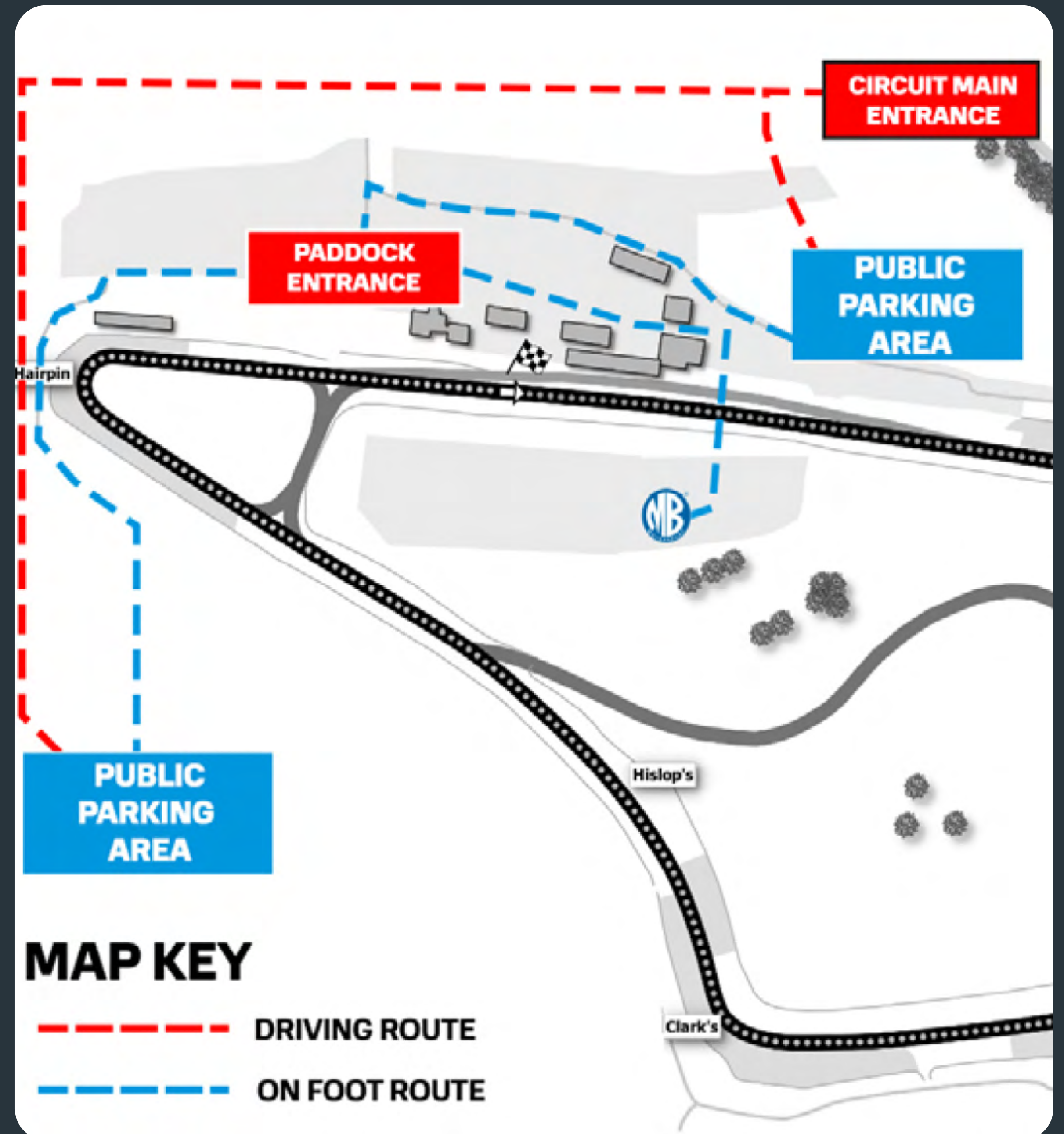

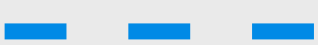

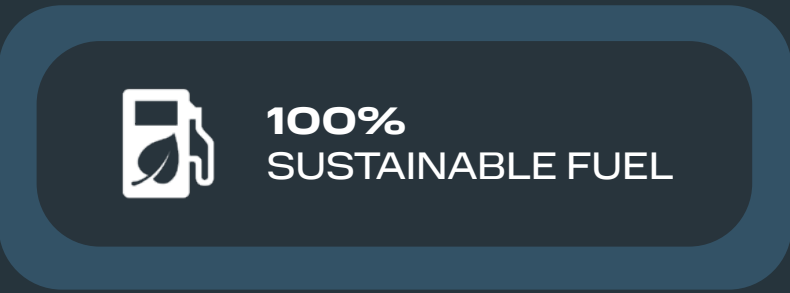

INTRODUCING THE BTCC



RACING IN THE BRITISH TOURING CAR CHAMPIONSHIP:

The British Touring Car Championship represents the UK’s premier format of motor racing. A British sporting institution, the BTCC has been a family favourite for over 60 years and is the globe’s third longest running motor racing series behind Formula One and Nascar.

Famed for its incredible access and no-holds-barred racing, the BTCC provides a fantastic spectacle and an exciting race experience for the millions of fans who tune in to ITV’s terrestrial TV coverage as well as the hundreds of thousands of fans who line the circuits nationwide.

A pioneer in their own field, the BTCC in 2022 became the world’s first touring car series to implement hybrid power units in every car on the grid. Alongside this, now in 2025 each car now runs off a 100% sustainable fuel.

In doing so, the BTCC has become the greenest form of touring car racing in the world - an incredibly important factor as the series remains one of the most relevant and attractive to the automotive market and car enthusiasts worldwide.

Unlike many forms of high-level motorsport, the BTCC’s popularity is rising with every passing year. In 2023, four of the hosting circuits broke their attendance record at each round.

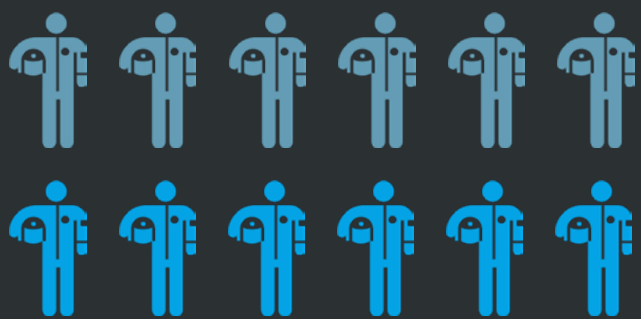
HOW DOES BTCC 'QUICK SIX' QUALIFYING WORK?



The drivers are divided into two groups for the opening qualifying session.

Group 1 - Drivers who finished in odd positions in FP2.

Group 2 - Drivers who finished in even positions in FP2.



The 6 fastest drivers from each group progress to the 'Fast 12' in the next session.



The 'Quick Six' drivers then battle it out for the top 6 grid positions in the final session.

From his dad walking the paddock, trying to find someone who could pay for a new bumper so he could take part in his Ginetta season finale to being unable to complete his initial BTCC campaigns, **Jake understands the value of hard work more than most.**

Since 2019, Jake has worked with Mark Blundell and MB Motorsport, with his career skyrocketing. Now as the reigning BTCC champion, Jake is viewed by many **as the grid's most talented driver** having now racked up 20 career wins and 59 podiums.

INTRODUCING MARK BLUNDELL



A legend of British Motorsport, Mark Blundell drove at the pinnacle of motorsport throughout his career, racing in F1, IndyCar, World Rally Championship, British Touring Car Championship and the Le Mans 24 Hours.

After progressing his way through the junior ranks, Mark enjoyed a distinguished career at the very top of the sport. 61 starts in Formula One brought multiple podium finishes whilst racing for the likes of McLaren, Brabham, Ligier and Tyrrell across a golden era for the sport. Alongside his Formula One duties, Mark enjoyed immense sportscar success, most notably taking a memorable pole position at the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1990 before taking the outright victory in 1992.

Mark also became one of the very first British drivers to enjoy a great deal of success in the United States, taking on the very best that IndyCar had to offer enjoying multiple wins along the way.

Stepping away from elite racing, Mark was a part of ITV's BAFTA-award winning Formula One coverage from 2003 to 2008 and has established himself as one of Europe's most recognised motorsport managers through his role as CEO of market-leading sports management group, MBP.
