A movie review should begin with an introduction, followed by a brief summary of the movie, then your analysis and evaluation, and end with a conclusion.

1. Introduction

- Film title, director, release year
- Genre or style
- Brief hook about the film's impact or uniqueness

Example Starters:

- Directed by [Director's Name], [Film Title] (Year) explores...
- At first glance, this [genre] film promises...
- What immediately stands out about [Film Title] is...

2. Plot Summary

- Setting and time period
- Main characters and their goals
- Central conflict or challenge

Example Starters:

- The story follows [Character Name] as they...
- Set in [location/time], the film centers on...
- Without giving too much away, the plot revolves around...



3. Analysis of Film Elements

- Direction and storytelling style
- Acting performances
- Cinematography and visual style
- Soundtrack and sound design
- Themes and symbolism
- Pacing and editing

- The lighting/colors enhance the mood by ...

5. Conclusion

- Summarize your review briefly
- Restate your main opinion
- Leave a final impression
