## **SBAR Communication**



#### **Situation:**

- State the immediate issue or reason for communication.
- Include patient name, age, diagnosis, and current concern.



## **Background:**

- Provide relevant patient history.
- · Include medical history, recent procedures, or current treatments.



### **Assessment:**

- · Summarize current clinical findings.
- Include vital signs, lab results, physical exam notes, and nurse's observations.



#### **Recommendation:**

- Suggest the next steps or actions.
- Examples: further tests, medication adjustments, physician evaluation, or changes to the care plan.



## **Expected Outcomes:**

- · Note desired results after recommendation is carried out.
- Examples: stable vitals, symptom relief, patient safety, improved comfort.
